## Tokyo Rose Granted Stay

SAN FRANCISCO (AP)—Efforts to deport Mrs. Iva Toguri D'Aquino, known to GIs as Tokyo Rose for her propaganda efforts over the Japanese radio during World War II, have been dropped.

District Immigration Director Bruce Barber said yesterday the federal government canceled the warrant for Mrs. D'Aquino's arrest for deportation because of a U. S. Supreme Court decision. The court held the citizenship of a soldier who deserted in Germany could not be canceled after he returned to U. S. territory.

Mrs. D'Aquino, now 42, was graduated from the University of California at Los Angeles. She was in Japan visiting relatives when World War II broke out.

After the war she was arrested in Japan and convicted of treason at a trial in San Francisco. She served six years and two months of a 10-year sentence before being paroled in 1956.

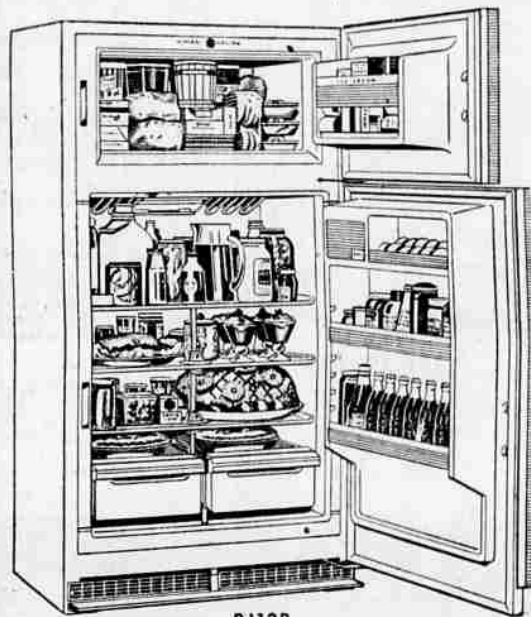
