Traffic Violation, Accident Ratio Seen

SACRAMENTO (UPI) — The Governor's Safety Council reports that there is a close relationship between traffic law violations and the number of accidents on our highways.

The council says this can be seen by the fact that 47.5 per cent of all drivers in reportable accidents last year were cited for traffic violations. An even higher percentage, 56.4 per cent, of the drivers in fatal accidents were cited for breaking traffic laws.

Speed was said to be the number one violation, being involved in 35.1 per cent of all reportable accidents which occurred last year, either for exceeding state limits or for exceeding a safe speed for conditions.

Responsibility Pill Suggested

BERKELEY (UPI)—A University of California doctor has suggested a "responsibility pill" for alcoholics to integrate them with reality, improve their behavior and strengthen their prudence.

Dr. Keith S. Ditman, director of the Alcoholic Research Clinic at the university, described such a pharmaceutical fantasy to emphasize the hazards of tranquilizers and sedatives.
