The new construction includes an addition to the main office building. One room will be occupied by the ranger for the newly formed Ukonom District until adequate facilities can be built in the vicinity of Ishi-Pishi Falls for that district.

A new residence for the Ukonom District ranger, George M. Combes, is nearing completion at Forest Service Camp at Curly Jack's near the mouth of Elk Creek at Happy Camp.

Community Council Plans To Hold Public Meeting

A meeting of the Community Council of Klamath County has been set tentatively for Monday, July 28, at a time and place to be announced later.

It will be an open meeting featuring important reports from committees.

Among them will be a report on a recommended revised constitution and bylaws; another on a suggested budget of expenditures and method of finance; and a report on redrafting of incorporation articles.

Council Chairman Herman (Bud) Smith reports work has already started on compilation of an information file on health, welfare and recreation services in the county. This is the initial project of the Community Council. A committee and chairman to see it through is expected to be appointed July 28. Smith said enrollment of members into the council will begin as soon as constitution and by-laws have been adopted.

He reported also that the council has been recognized by the Oregon United Appeal.

Booklets are now available at the United Fund office, Wall and Esplanade, explaining the Community Council's functions. They will also be on hand at the July 28 meeting.

Chairman Smith stressed that the upcoming gathering will be an "all important" one and urged all interested to attend.
