SACRAMENTO (AP)—The State Department of Agriculture this month took over enforcement of state laws to prevent escape of the nutria.
The big, vegetarian rodent is regarded as a serious pest in areas where it has escaped and become established. It eats crops, competes with game birds for natural food, and burrows in levees and canals.
The animal, also known as the coypu and South American beaver, is raised for its fur.

School Board Receives Bids

Two bids were received by the school board of District No. 1 at the Monday evening meeting for reroofing Fremont School, 715 High Street, according to Harold B. Ashley, clerk of the school district.

Bidders were Henris Roofing Company, \$3,687 and C. Fitzgerald, \$4,798.50.

The work involved includes furnishing and applying approximately 132 squares of Johns-Manville type built-up roofing. The regular roofing squares are 100 square foot sections each.

As the amounts bid were above the estimated cost of the repair work, a special committee was named to study the bids and also to investigate the possibility of bonded roofing. The committee will report at the school board meeting to be held at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, August 11.

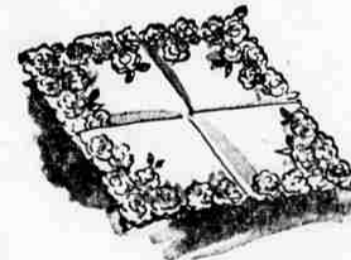

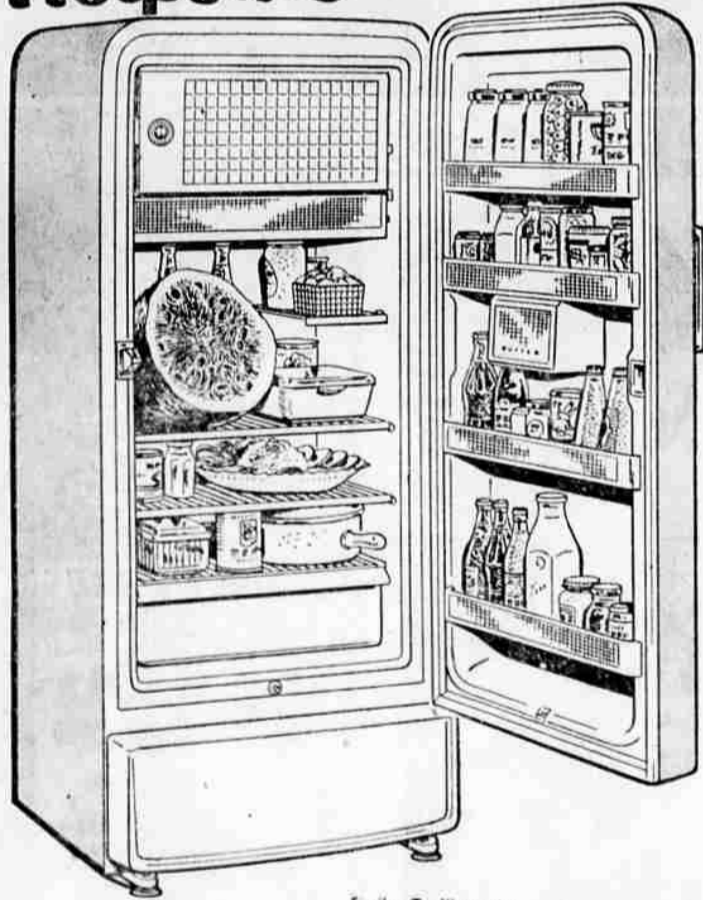
