

# Citizens Use Palaces As Playgrounds

BAGHDAD (UPI)—Palaces once occupied by ex-Premier Nuri Es Said, ex-King Faisal and ex-Crown Prince Abdul Illah have become amusement spots for Baghdad citizens.

A steady stream of men, women and children pours through Said's wrecked palace on the banks of the Tigris, and hundreds of others collect outside the walls of the royal palace near the airport.

In the entry hall of Said's air-conditioned home, a man sells cakes. Outside vendors do a big business in ice cream, soft drinks and ice water.

While soldiers watch, crowds throng through the once-luxurious

house which is stripped of all furniture, rugs, pictures and trinkets.

What is left of the furniture now is stored in locked rooms, but a glance through the windows shows that the mob that attacked the house had a chance to rip upholstery and smash radios, phonographs and air-conditioning units before order was restored.

The house, set in a grove of date and palm trees, contrasts strikingly with nearby mud-brick homes of poor Iraqis.

The scene at the royal palace where Faisal, Abdul Illah and other members of the royal palace were shot is different.

Crowds are kept out of the palace grounds and only newsmen and officials are permitted to enter.

The building itself is completely gutted by fire, which some say was started by mobs and others by the army's armored cars.

Outside on the lawn are scattered what personal belongings and furniture were salvaged from the blaze. Hundreds of pictures from the King's personal collection were strewn about, mixed with jade vases, kitchen ware, clothes and bric-a-brac.

Alongside a tree near which some say Faisal was shot is an undersized military jacket stripped of all decorations, buttons and shoulder insignia. An army captain on duty there said it belonged to the young king.

Upstairs in the three-story palace is one of the few things left in the building, an "exercise cycle" which Faisal used to keep fit.

Among the debris on the lawn is the only portrait of the royal family to survive unharmed. It is of King Hussein I, the founder of the Hashemite dynasty.

A visitor can see on leaving the palace grounds that the crowds that adorned the gates have been stripped off.

Between the actions of the mobs and the new government there is little to remind a stranger that this was once a king's palace.

## Iraq Desert Spot Is Where Oil Begins And Might End

KIRKUK, Iraq (UPI)—This is where it all begins and this is where it all may end some day.

Here or near here is the fabulous Kirkuk oil belt. Here are a maze of coils, chimneys, tank farms, generators and pumps—all incredibly quiet in their movement under the fierce summer heat.

And from here spider out the pipelines in the Mediterranean, across hundreds of miles of desert.

A little more than 750,000 gallons of oil an hour are now passing quietly through the 30-inch and two 16-inch arteries westward.

It goes at a pulsating 45 miles an hour, regenerated when impetus lags by isolated desert pumping stations with names such as K2, K3.

Iraqis, Scotsmen, Britons, Americans, French, Dutch and many other nationalities sweat to keep the oil moving.

When not outside in the merciless sun they pore over charts, graphs, analyses in the blessed comfort of air-conditioned offices.

It is not had working for the Iraq Petroleum Company inside. It's pretty rough outside.

I drive up through the "outside" from Baghdad to see how the revolution affected this goldmine of black oil. So far, not a bit.

If anything, the IPC is increasing its production. Nothing has been touched—and the army is

making sure that nothing will be touched.

The big IPC plants lie just north of Kirkuk which is a sprawling oasis city of houses, none more than two or three stories.

The plants, sprawled over many square miles, are as quiet as the desert itself. It is automation at its supreme. Only the occasional deep hum of a generator breaks the silence.

You climb up a big circular glass dome and see nothing but machinery and heat waves distorting straight things into corkscrews.

Yet down there are at least 1,000 persons working at any one time. And you never see oil.

Only the soft whine of a generator and the noticeable spinning of an axle indicate motion.

Everything looked normal, two weeks after the revolution.
