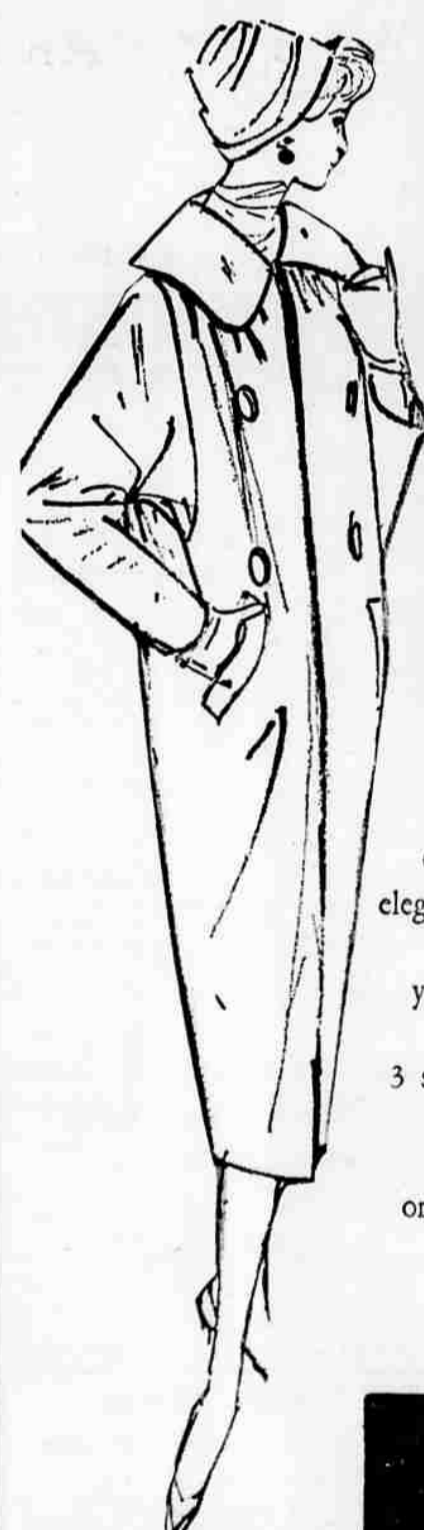
The young couple was married in the Community Baptist Church in China Lake on Sunday, July 27.
