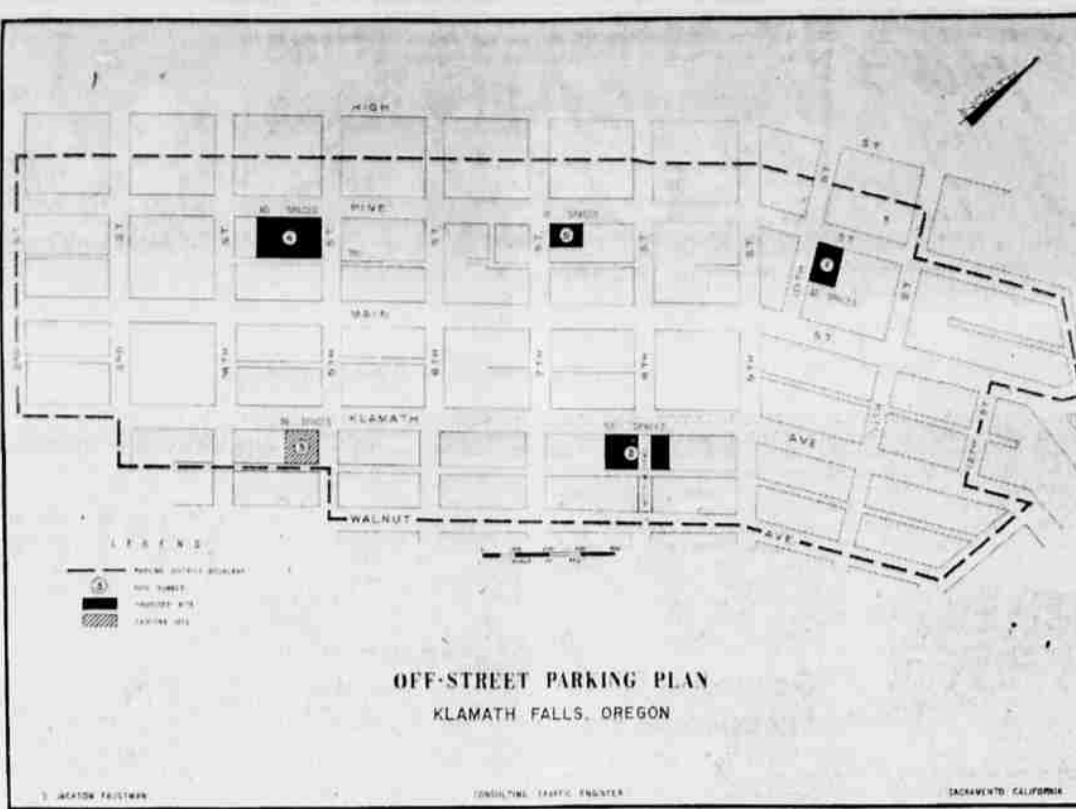
Crash Kills Glider Pilot

Survey Calls For Five Lot Parking Plan

By FLOYD WYNNE A recommendation for development of five short time parking lots containing a total of 212 parking spaces at a cost of \$297,650 and the opening of Eighth Street between Walnut and Klamath Avenue, were the two keystones in the recent off-street parking survey completed by D. Jackson Faustman, consulting traffic engineer from Sacramento.

He recommends, "Sufficient and adequate short time parking facilities are a necessity for the maintenance of the economic health of the central district wherein are located the major business, commercial and retail establishments." The five short time parking sites recommended in the report consist of: (1) the corner lot at Tenth and Pine which will accommodate 32 spaces; (2) the opening of Eighth Street plus use of parking room on both sides of such an opened street, 58 spaces; (3) use of the present city-owned site at the corner of Fifth and Klamath, 36 spaces; (4) the major share of the half block on the south side of Pine between Fourth and Fifth streets, 65 spaces; and (5) the corner of Seventh and Pine, adjacent to the YMCA, 21 spaces.

Auto Workers For Striking

DETROIT (AP) — The United Auto Workers today virtually completed tabulation of strike authorization votes at Big Three plants. It showed 312,768 voting in favor of strike action if necessary to back up the union's goals in current bargaining talks with General Motors, Ford and Chrysler. The vote against was given as 15,191. Since June 1, some 400,000 UAW members have been working without contracts at Big Three plants. UAW Vice President Leonard Woodcock, in charge of negotiations with GM, reported yesterday a final tabulation at the UAW's 120 GM units showed 115,973 voting for a strike and 10,410 against. GM normally employs between 325,000 and 350,000 hourly workers. The union said returns from 52 out of 55 Ford locals showed 56,235 votes for a strike and 2,533 against. The vote at 37 of 38 Chrysler locals was given as 40,560 in favor and 2,248 against. UAW President Walter P. Reuther has called a meeting of the union's 25-man executive board in Detroit Friday to consider possible strike action.

Hoffa Returns To Testify

WASHINGTON (AP) — Senate racket investigators called back Teamsters boss James R. Hoffa today to explain his relations with Teamster official Frank Kierdorf, victim of an alleged fire torture in Michigan. Kierdorf, 56, was business agent for a Teamsters local at Flint, Mich., and was a Fifth Amendment witness before the committee last November. He said he was kidnapped from his Flint home Sunday night, doused with an inflammable liquid and set afire by two unknown assailants. Officers since have raised questions about that story. Hoffa declined comment when queried about the incident. The committee, resuming its bitter feud with Hoffa, sought yesterday's testimony to portray Hoffa as a recipient of payoffs to settle labor disputes in 1949 between his union and Detroit laundry operators — at the expense of laundry truck drivers fighting for a five-day week. Witnesses said to avoid a city-wide Teamsters strike that year, Detroit laundry owners made a secret \$17,500 payoff over a three-year period. Several of the witnesses called it extortion and two of them said they thought some of the money went to Hoffa. But they said they couldn't swear to it. Hoffa, who last appeared before the committee a year ago, was called back as part of the committee inquiry into asserted underworld ties of various labor and business groups in Detroit and elsewhere. The Teamster leader pleaded he couldn't recall much about his role in helping to settle the Detroit laundry strike.
