BRITISH TV
LONDON (UPI)—The number of television viewers in Britain increased by about 17 per cent during the 12 months ending June 30, 1958—from 19,600,000 to 22,900,000. The average set owners spent 10 hours a week watching TV. About 62 per cent of the audience preferred commercial programs to those of the government BBC.

Eels Put On Electrifying Show

DETROIT (UPI)—One eel equals about 300 volts and about 1,000 watts—and in Detroit's Belle Isle aquarium it all adds up to an electrifying show.

Curator Lee Finneran has started three daily exhibitions starring his three eels, some wires and a row of electric lights. Finneran said the eels' tails carry the negative charge and their heads the positive charge.

When aquarium aides, well protected with rubber gloves, place metal contacts on the head and tail of an eel brought into position beneath the row of 24 neon bulbs, the bulbs begin flashing.

Finneran said he'd like to but can't step up the number of performances. The electric organs of the eels can only supply so much power before they have to be rested and allowed to recharge.

Cake Almost Too Much For Actress

HOLLYWOOD (UPI) — Barbara Billingsley, who plays the mother in the "Leave It to Beaver" series (CBS-TV), thinks she may face a weight problem any time now. Director Norman Tokar wasn't too happy with a dining room scene, so she had to eat three pieces of gooey chocolate cake for re-takes.

The cast broke for lunch, and Miss Billingsley decided to have another piece of cake. When shooting resumed, Tokar said they'd have to do the morning's work over again—he wasn't satisfied. So she had to eat a total of nine pieces of cake before the scene was approved by Tokar.

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
