### Jazz Moves In On Home Ground Of Waltz Kings

VIENNA (UPI)—Vienna's leading jazz man has announced plans to make the Austrian capital Europe's jazz metropolis—by bringing New Orleans to the city of the Strausses.

Franz Pressler, better known to European jazz fans as "Fatty George," has purchased a former Viennese night club, the "Casino Oriental," well-known to U.S. soldiers during the four-power occupation of Austria—and plans to transform it into Europe's most original "jazzy saloon."

By doing this, Fatty George will make Vienna worthy of its unofficial title as musical center of the world when the new nitery opens this fall. Fatty plans to build in a New Orleans riverboat, a part of Chicago in miniature, a police station complete with cell and an old fire engine. All these will be arranged so that Austrian jazz fans will be able to sit and dance in a picturesque atmosphere.

According to the plans, there will be room for 350 guests. One third of them will have room to dance, while two bands play. The customers will be able to sit between the funnels of the "Mississippi Riverboat," or on a typical Mississippi bridge.

The cooking will be a la New Orleans. And there'll be Southern fried chicken on the menu. American jazz singer Al "Fats" Edwards will be the star of the show. He may do more than just sing, though. He may also help out as a specialist on Louisiana cooking in the jazz kitchen.
