INCREASE

PORTLAND (AP)—New social security legislation passed by Congress would provide an estimated monthly increase of \$100,000 in federal matching funds for some 28,000 cases in Oregon, the state public welfare administrator said Thursday.

Jeanne Jewett said the bill would increase aid to the blind, aid to dependent children and aid to permanently and totally disabled.

The bill now is before President Eisenhower.

Missing Boat Theory Held

SEATTLE (AP)—The Coast Guard Thursday linked the mystery of a boat spotted burning off Tatoosh Island last November with that of a missing gillnetter, which disappeared about the same time.

The boat which was seen burning by the Japanese freighter Meitetsu Maru on Nov. 2 was the 32-foot gillnetter Jo-Jo, skippered by Frank Brown of Nanaimo, B.C. according to a Coast Guard report.

A gas tank found in the area after the Japanese ship's report proved to be the key to the mystery. The tank was identified in Victoria as positively being from the missing Jo-Jo.

Brown left Tofino, on the west coast of Vancouver Island, last Oct. 30 en route to Nanaimo. Neither Brown nor his boat was seen again, except apparently by the crew of the freighter when it came upon the burning craft 45 miles off Tatoosh Island.
