## Horror Is Still 'New' In Television

NEW YORK (UPI)—"C'est fantastique!"

This refers, not to Brigitte Bardot, but to the latest small trend in filmed television series.

The "fantastic" concept may replace last year's popular word, "Horror!"

Rather than risk frightening youngsters with horror shows, various TV film syndicators are trying to put on a "family" show that incorporates the best of science-fiction and horror yarns.

Three "fantastics" are making the rounds and more are in the planning stage. The three ready for viewing are "The Invisible Man," an adaptation of the famous H. G. Wells character, "Witch's Tale," and "World of Giants."

The Columbia Broadcasting System, hoping to cut into the popularity of "Wagon Train," the hour-long adult western seen on NBC-TV each Wednesday, is tossing "The Invisible Man" and "World of Giants" opposite the Ward Bond-Robert Horton series.

"World of Giants" represents a four million dollar investment and a rather interesting pictorial approach.

The hero in this story is Mel Hunter, portrayed by Marshall Thompson. Hunter is a six-foot FBI man who shrinks to a mere six-inches after being exposed to the rays from guided missile fuel somewhere behind the Iron Curtain.

Rather than discharge Hunter for not measuring up to the physical standards of the FBI, the government decides to use him for top secret missions. He is carried on his missions in a special briefcase.

Once let loose, of course, he is confronted by a world of giants. An ordinary chair, to him, becomes a Mount Everest. A cleaning woman using a vacuum cleaner almost destroys him. The ashes from a lighted cigar almost bury him. A cat goes after him in the mistaken notion that he's some sort of new-fangled rodent. And lifting a telephone receiver off the hook becomes a chore requiring supermidget strength.
