



### Man Survives Plane Crash

WILSONVILLE (AP)—A light plane clipped a power line and crash-landed on the bank of the Willamette River southwest of here Sunday. The pilot survived.

Worth O. Wiley, 58, who was returning to a landing strip on his farm near Dayton, said he was following the river "looking at the water skiers" when the low-flying plane struck the power line.

It nosed into the river bank and overturned. Wiley untangled himself from the cockpit and was taken ashore by two witnesses, Howard E. Renner of Newberg and Al Cummings of Albany.

Wiley suffered multiple cuts, bruises and a concussion.

He was returning from Newberg after flying in some corn for the annual Flying Farmers' Corn Feed there.

CAIRO (AP)—The Cairo press reported today Lebanon's President-elect Fuad Chehab, wants to begin his administration Sept. 23 with personal talks with President Nasser and Iraqi leader Abdul Karim Kassem.

The report, distributed by Egypt's Middle East News Agency, was unconfirmed officially.

### Jakarta Bars Nationalists

JAKARTA, Indonesia (AP)—The Jakarta administration today banned all activities by the Chinese charging it "endangered the peace, order and security of the Republic of Indonesia." Indonesia recognized Communist China eight years ago. The decree is believed aimed mostly at schools and social organizations of Nationalist-sympathizing Chinese.

### Group Suggests 5-Member Board

PORTLAND (AP)—A five-member state Highway Commission rather than the present three members was proposed Saturday by the Legislative Interim Committee on Highways.

The recommendation, approved by a 6-1 vote, will be submitted to the 1959 Legislature.

### State Fair Run Opens Thursday

SALEM (AP)—The 97th annual Oregon State Fair will open a ten-day run here Thursday.

Workmen have been putting up booths and making other preparations for the big show during the past week.

The traditional ribbon-cutting ceremony has been abandoned for this year. Instead, Gov. Robert D. Holmes will saw a 22-inch log in two to usher in the fair.

It was not announced whether the governor would use a power or hand saw.

## Alaskans Vote Tomorrow On Becoming State

JUNEAU, Alaska (AP)—A generation on debate on the merits of statehood for Alaska will be settled tomorrow at the polls.

A "yes" vote — on three-separate referendum propositions — would mean creation of the new state probably in late December or early January. Actual admission will come with the issuance of a presidential proclamation after the results are in from a general election in November.

Most forecasts were that statehood would carry by at least a 2-1 majority of the more than 35,000 ballots that are expected to be cast. For the first time in Alaska, 19 and 20-year-old residents will be among those voting.

Opposition to the end of territorial status has come largely from residents who fear new and higher taxes to support a state government.

Many federal employees in the territory also have expressed fears that statehood would bring an end to a 25 per cent cost of living allowance they now receive for working in Alaska.

For the first time, Alaskans will be voting for officials seeking elective offices of governor and secretary of state. In addition, candidates will be nominated for two U.S. Senate seats and one seat in the U.S. House.

If statehood carries in the referendum, a general election to name the first state officials will be held Nov. 25.

### Townsend Off Around World

BRUSSELS, Belgium (AP)—Group Capt. Peter Townsend, former suitor of Princess Margaret of Britain, will leave Brussels tonight for another round-the-world trip on which he will make a feature color film.

Jean Dalrymple, coordinator of the performing arts program at the U. S. pavilion at the World Fair, said Townsend returned to Britain Sunday night after a holiday in Belgium.
