

Rare Element Is Isolated

GENEVA (UPI)—U. S. experts have isolated a weighable quantity of californium, the most explosive substance ever known, but the time and money required indicate it cannot be produced in practical volume.

Nobel Prize physicist Glenn T. Seaborg told the "atoms for peace" convention here it took several years to isolate 0.06 micrograms of californium—considerably less than a millionth of an ounce.

The element, one of a series of artificial substances created by atomic reactors, is so unstable its atoms split at a terrific spontaneous rate. Scientists here believe it may be a factor in the giant stellar explosions which create "super-novas," which are exploding stars.

Seaborg said even "weightless and invisible" quantities of californium produce measurable numbers of neutrons—the tiny particles that cause nuclear explosions.
