West Coast Shipbuilders Hail Decision By Navy

SAN FRANCISCO (UPI)—West Coast shipbuilders hailed today a decision of the Navy to award contracts on the basis of better delivery or the location of shipyards.

Hugh Gallagher, chairman of Mayor George Christopher's Committee on Shipbuilding, said the Navy decision means that "higher construction costs on the West Coast won't put us at a competitive disadvantage of East Coast yards."

"This is what we've been working for," Gallagher said. "Even if Bethlehem or New York Ship on the East Coast can do the job cheaper, we can still get the contracts."

Private shipyards will be bidding for 70 contracts authorized in the Navy's 1959 ship appropriation of \$2,069,000,000.

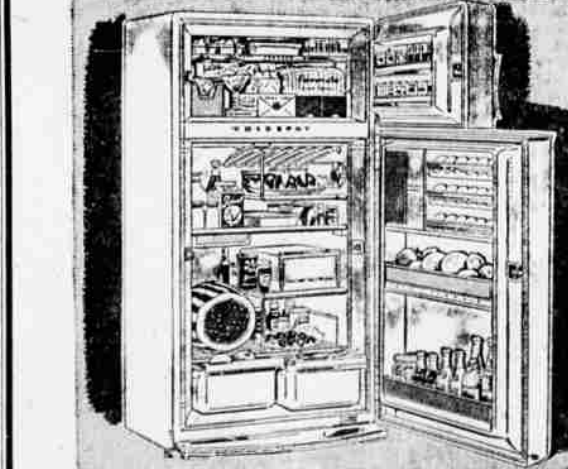

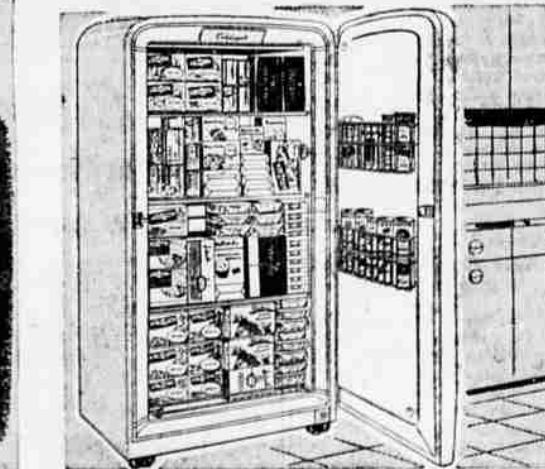

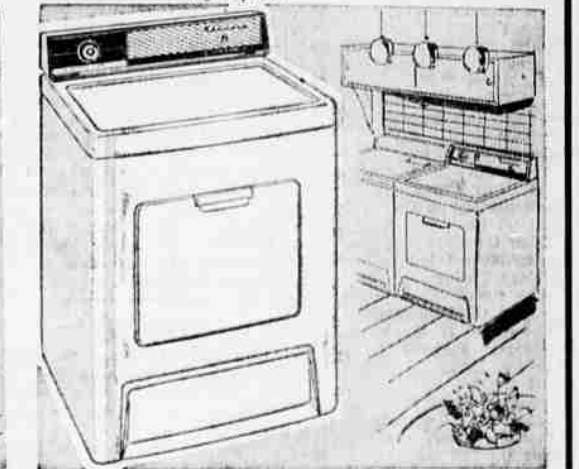
