Musical Comedy Author Totes Book 'Little Women'

NEW YORK (AP) — Composer Richard Adler would have more peace these days if absolutely everybody in the country would understand why he refused to kill a girl named Meg.

Meg is one of the principal characters in Louisa May Alcott's "Little Women," which will be presented on CBS-TV Oct. 16 as a one-hour special television musical written by Adler.

At the conclusion of "Little Women," published in 1868, Meg was alive at the age of 14. The book became so popular—one of the persistent best-sellers of its age—that Miss Alcott wrote a sequel entitled "Good Wives." In the sequel Meg dies at the age of 19. Delay Judge Is Retired

NEWPORT, R.I. (AP) — President Eisenhower today approved retirement from active service for U.S. Dist. Judge Harry J. Lemley. It was Lemley's decision granting a delay in school integration at Little Rock, Ark., that led to an overruling go-ahead by the U.S. Supreme Court.

The summer White House announced that Judge Lemley requested retirement for reasons of impaired health. He is past the eligible retirement age—70 years. Eisenhower's approval of retirement is retroactive to Sept. 5, the date the judge requested that he be relieved.

The President wrote Judge Lemley thanking him for his years of service as a member of the federal judiciary. Eisenhower also expressed hope that relief from active duty will lead to improved health.

Lemley was appointed to the federal bench May 11, 1939.

China Claim Is Rejected

LONDON (AP)—Britain has officially rejected Red China's proclaimed extension of her territorial waters to 12 miles, the Foreign Office said today.

In a note to the Peiping government Saturday, Britain affirmed that her ships had every right under international law to sail to within three miles of mainland China's coastline. Britain recognizes only a three-mile territorial waters limit and herself applies that limit around territories under her control throughout the world.

Atlas Missile Fired Sunday

CAPE CANAVERAL, Fla. (AP) — The Air Force has successfully fired another Atlas, setting the stage for the first attempt to shoot the missile at intercontinental range.

Atlas, the most powerful war rocket in the free world at present, blasted away early Sunday on another 3,000-mile test of guidance and strength.

The first full-range Atlas shot—some 6,325 miles—is expected soon.

Fort Performs, But No British In Re-Enactment

Jets Arrive In Formosa

AIRBASE, Southern Formosa (AP) — A contingent of F104 Starfighters has arrived in Formosa. Also newly arrived in Formosa is a composite U.S. air strike force—the recently created "small war deterrent" force capable of delivering nuclear weapons and the same type of unit that was sent to the Middle East last July.

The number of Starfighters arriving was not disclosed. The initial group is at a base in Northern Formosa.

The detachment probably came to Formosa from Hamilton Air Force Base in California, which announced recently that a unit of Starfighters had left for overseas duty.

The composite strike force, an innovation in air warfare, is an all-around, self-contained unit with a variety of planes. These include:

F100 Super Sabre Jets, RB66 destroyers, RF101 Voodoo reconnaissance planes, C130 Hercules turboprop cargo planes and KB50J tankers which have four propeller engines and two jets.

The strike force left the West Coast of the United States Aug. 29.

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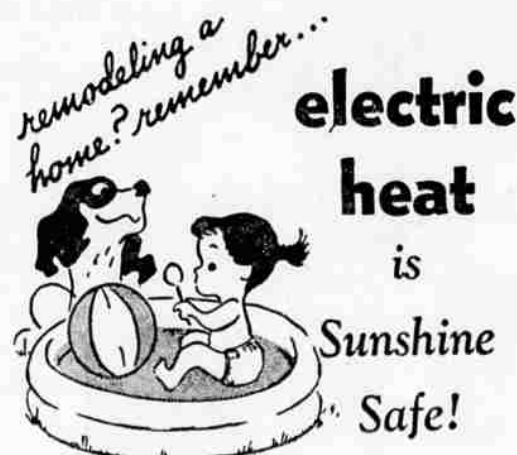


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
