

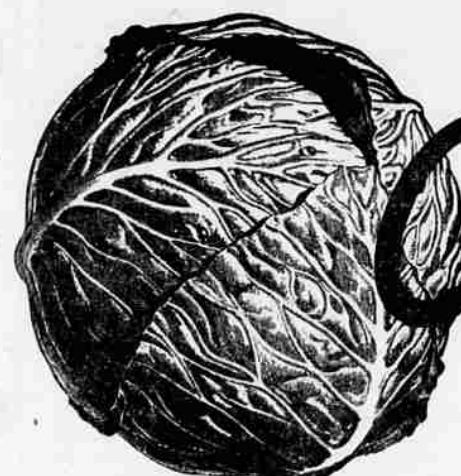

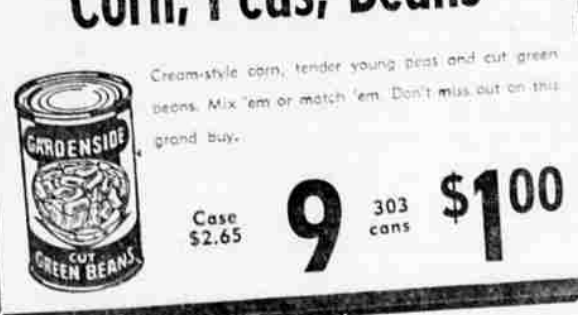

Civil Defense, Red Cross Planning Disaster Drill

Monday night's disaster drill planned by the Klamath Basin Chapter, American Red Cross and Klamath County Chapter of Civil Defense, could be a reality with the horrifying aftermath of a giant explosion that rocks the city of Klamath Falls.

This possibility and the need to be prepared in the event of such a war holocaust, determined plans of the local Red Cross and the civil defense to hold a disaster drill at the Klamath County Fair grounds on September 15.

The drill will follow completion of meetings and classes held recently to prepare for the simulated disaster.

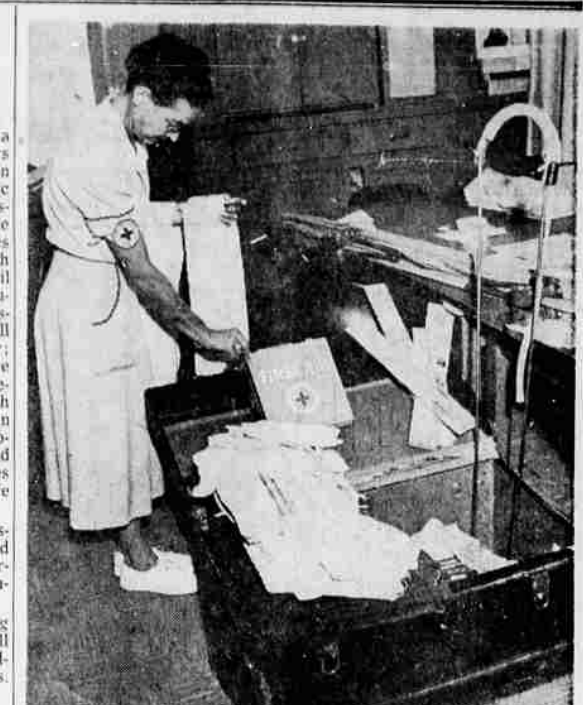
Notices have been sent to all key people in the disaster plan, and Otto Smith, Red Cross disaster chairman, and M. G. Gordon, civil defense director, urge all who received tickets to be present. Anyone who has not yet replied may call the Red Cross office Monday.

Mass serving of food under disaster conditions will be undertaken by the volunteer crews, in addition to other emergency assistance.

Supposition is that a terrific explosion has occurred in the South Sixth Street area, followed by fire that is still raging through the area.

With this supposition, and disaster drill, civil defense and Red Cross will demonstrate the cooperation of the two agencies in teaching self protection and care.

The annual Red Cross meeting will be open to all persons holding Red Cross membership cards.
