Prisoners Use Time To Earn

NEW YORK (UPI) — A "lifer" in the Illinois Penitentiary hopes to make \$21,000 during 1958. Legitimately.

Clyde Wagner expects to accumulate that much from royalties on the sale of 700,000 "Kongo Safari's" — a toy elephant that he invented in his spare time.

Roy Weightman of the Ohio Penitentiary is another inmate who has put his "time" to good use, inventing the "Spot-a-Satellite" game.

Others in the prison population make crossword puzzles. A few supply cartoonists with gag lines. Many write stories and articles.

Income from these projects ranges from \$1 to \$100 and higher, according to an analysis of "penitentiary pay dirt" in the current issue of Ohio Penitentiary News.

The publication warned the inmates, however, it's a good idea to "send yourself a carbon copy of your creation by registered and sealed mail, and just keep the sealed envelope as proof of origin and date.

"It may seem funny to say this ... but be careful. There are an awful lot of crooks out there."
