

Semester Passing Quietly For Integrated Students

RALEIGH, N.C. (AP)—Ten Negro children are attending five predominantly white schools during the second year of limited token integration in three North Carolina cities—Greensboro, Winston-Salem and Charlotte.

Except for two incidents involving disputes between white and Negro children, the first four weeks of the term apparently have passed quietly at the five schools.

At Greensboro, Russell Herring, 13, was sent home two weeks ago by officials at Gillespie Park School for fighting with another student. Elijah Herring told reporters his son was defending himself from a boy who tried to choke him. Four other Negroes attend his school. Officials would not say whether young Herring was expelled or suspended.

The other incident came at Charlotte's Central High School. Gus Roberts, the only Negro student, tussled with a white youth. The white boy was suspended for a day.

It is Roberts' second year at Central. His 13-year-old sister Girvaud is attending Piedmont Junior High School, also for the second year.

MDs Report Cancer Mimic

WASHINGTON (AP) — Two Philadelphia radiologists said today a number of noncancerous conditions in the upper part of the stomach can mimic cancer.

Doctors should be wary of jumping too quickly to diagnostic conclusions, Dr. George T. Wohl and Dr. Lea Shore said in a report prepared for the 59th annual meeting of the American Roentgen Ray Society.

Diagnosis of cancer in the upper end of the stomach has long been a challenge to radiologists, they said. Numerous X-ray pictures from various angles often must be taken and the results compared with the physical symptoms presented by the patient.

Even then, the doctors said, surgical exploration of the stomach may be needed to rule definitely whether cancer is or is not present.

Among noncancerous conditions which may be present, they said, are benign tumors, ulcers and postoperative deformities. Pressure from such normal structures as the liver, spleen or kidney can also cause diagnostic signs and symptoms mimicking cancer, they said.

Oregon Chief Named By UPI

SAN FRANCISCO (UPI) — Appointment of Willard D. Eberhart as United Press International manager for Oregon is announced in San Francisco by Richard Litfin, Pacific Division manager.

Eberhart succeeds Jack Kerr, who has been transferred to San Francisco to become Pacific Division radio editor.

Eberhart joined the United Press in 1937 in Portland. He served in Seattle, Honolulu and Montreal in managements before becoming executive news manager for Canada in 1957. He is a journalism graduate from the University of Oregon.

Kerr worked on several Oregon newspapers after graduation from Oregon State. He joined the United Press in Portland after World War II service and became Oregon manager in 1951.

PICASSO BUYS CASTLE
AIX-EN-PROVENCE, France (UPI) — Artist Pablo Picasso has paid nearly one million dollars for a 300-year-old castle which formerly belonged to French Marshal Philippe Petain. It was reported today.
