Prison Radio Big Help As Peace Maker

FOLSOM, Calif. (UPI)—Authorities and inmates alike at California's maximum security penitentiary here are counting on a new radio program to stop prison riots before they get a chance to start.

The program, which is carried over the prison's "Gray Network," is called "For Your Information" and features frank discussions between prison officials and a panel of inmates.

The idea, according to the inmate newspaper, The Folsom Observer, is to give the prisoners the "why" behind the rules or orders which govern the institution.

"An order—or a rule—where no understanding of its cause, reason or value is apparent to the men affected by orders and rules, is not communication," the Observer said editorially.

It is such a lack of communication that causes resentment which eventually may lead to prison riots or other, less violent but perhaps equally serious, disturbances.

The communications can work both ways. A knowledge of the needs and wants of the prisoners can aid the men who are charged with administering the institution in carrying out their jobs.

"Authority is aware that certain problems exist in all prisons," the Observer editorial continued. "But authority will never—can never—understand those problems until they have spent the endless nights in the close cells, or lived the day by day waste of life."

William Lawson, an associate warden in charge of the radio program, said he thought it would help prison authorities understand better the feelings of inmates.

"The program is just good employee relations," Lawson said.

Already, Lawson said, it has begun to clear up misunderstandings between the jailed and the jailers.

"We find the men like to have the facts," Lawson emphasized.

The Observer predicted that once the program has had a chance to work its magic of communication, "each of us will understand more about the other."

"The Officer will understand that I do not growl at him because he is an officer, but because today my daughter is 12—and I have not seen her since she was five. I will understand that he does not growl at me because I am a convict, but because he has to pay doctor's bills, dress bills, the car payment—and here is this well-fed convict with no bills to pay, no worry about the rent. . . ."

Mustard Bath Is Soothing

ROCHESTER, N.Y. (UPI) — Nerves overwrought? Try a mustard bath instead of a tranquilizer.

So says a spokesman for the R. T. French Company, whose sales organization distributes an English-made mustard (Coleman's).

Doctors still recommend this old-fashioned remedy, the firm said. Studies by the American Heart Journal show that the tranquilizing effect of mustard in luke-warm water is due to increased flow of blood through the capillary veins at the skin's surface.

To make a mustard bath, dissolve 3 or 4 heaping tablespoons of dry mustard in a tub of luke-warm water. Relax in the tub for 15 minutes. Rub down with a soft towel, keep warm, and sleep if possible.
