

Klamath Falls Business And Professional Women Observe National Week

"More Power With Woman Power" Is Theme Of National Week

Local Business and Professional Club women have joined this past week with other members in the state and nation in observance of annual national BPW week. Tribute is paid to women in business and in the professions and the contribution they made to the nation.

The National Federation of BPW was formed in 1919 at St. Louis, Missouri. Its members now number 174,097 making it the largest organization in the world devoted to the affairs of women who actively share in the world's work and affairs.

The Klamath Falls chapter was established in 1924 and now has 119 members. The aim of the group is to elevate the standards

and promote the interests of business and professional women and to extend the status of women through education along lines of industrial, scientific and vocational activities, thus preparing them for leadership in the community and in their respective fields. Regular monthly meetings are held with programs designed to stress topics of interest to the women, such as legislation, national security, health and safety, international relations, public affairs and adult education.

The group observed the week with a social hour following the regular meeting October 6 to which prospective members were invited. Membership is open to any women employed in the professions, business or industry.
