Phone Company Plans Building

FORT JONES—Southern Oregon building contractors were informed recently of proposed plans of the Siskiyou Telephone Company to construct a general headquarters building at Fort Jones, California.

Plans and specifications, as prepared by Irwin Johnson, California architect, and Henry Dannenberg Jr., plant superintendent of the utility, were mailed to Cal-Ore Builders Exchange at Medford and Klamath Falls for examination by interested contractors.

The proposed building will cover an area of over 2,500 square feet to house dial and toll equipment, as well as operating personnel. It is intended to be the center of a modernization program of the utility under a loan recently granted by the Rural Electrification Administration to permit the conversion of telephone service in Western Siskiyou County from magneto to dial, with unattended toll units at Etna, Happy Camp and Hamburg, all in Siskiyou County, and operator and toll service furnished out of the Fort Jones building.

Bidding will be on a competitive basis and all interested parties are invited to contact the Builders' Exchange or the office of the company in Etna, California.
