Daughter of Mr. and Mrs. J. L. O'Donahue of Klamath Falls, the new appointee is a graduate of Henley High School and of Whitworth College, Spokane, where she received a B.S. degree, cum laude. She majored in general biology, with a minor in chemistry, and took a number of liberal arts courses.

In college, her extracurricular

activities included three years work on the Whitworthian, the school's All-American award-winning paper, where she specialized in humor features during her senior year. She also worked as an artist on the college yearbook. She was listed in "Who's who in American universities and colleges" during her senior year.

YREKA — Siskiyou County artists will display paintings in store windows during American Art Week, November 3 to 7, it was reported at the regular meeting of the Siskiyou Artists Association held at the Yreka Inn on Sunday, October 5.

The business session was conducted by the vice president, Mrs. Roy Dunham, in the absence of the president, Jerry Jenkins.

A general discussion predominated the afternoon relative to how to handle the many paintings that will be on display in Yreka, Montague, Weed, Gazelle, Mount Shasta and Dunsmuir.

Mrs. Ruby Churchill and Mrs. Betty Dow, both of Montague, canvassed Yreka and Montague merchants and Mrs. Churchill reported that 39 business firms in Yreka had agreed to display paintings and five merchants in Montague will also participate.

Mrs. Lucile Newton of Dunsmuir reported that one store in Mount Shasta, and two in Dunsmuir agreed to show pictures. Mrs. Calla Lukes, a noted painter herself from Etna, and who has had her work shown in New York, reported that Scott Valley artists prefer to display their pictures in Fort Jones and Etna.

Members are urged to attend the next meeting Sunday afternoon, November 2, and to bring two or three paintings with them, which will be used for display purposes.

Miss O'Donahue's previous experience with children has included work with the 4-H and the Mt. Laki Community Presbyterian Church Sunday School. She has had one year's work with the Camp Fire Girls and five with the Girl Scouts. She served as a camp counselor and nature instructor with the Girl Scouts. Her hobbies include drawing and painting, paleontology, slide photography, nature study, hiking and riding.

"We were very fortunate to be able to recruit someone like Pat for our staff," Miss Cooper says. "In addition to her other qualifications, her college background has prepared her to build up our book collection, especially in science."

One of Miss O'Donahue's duties will be to make the rounds on the bookmobile, which goes out to different schools of the county system every Tuesday and Thursday. She will be assisted by Vivian Wise, who is continuing as assistant to the children's librarian.

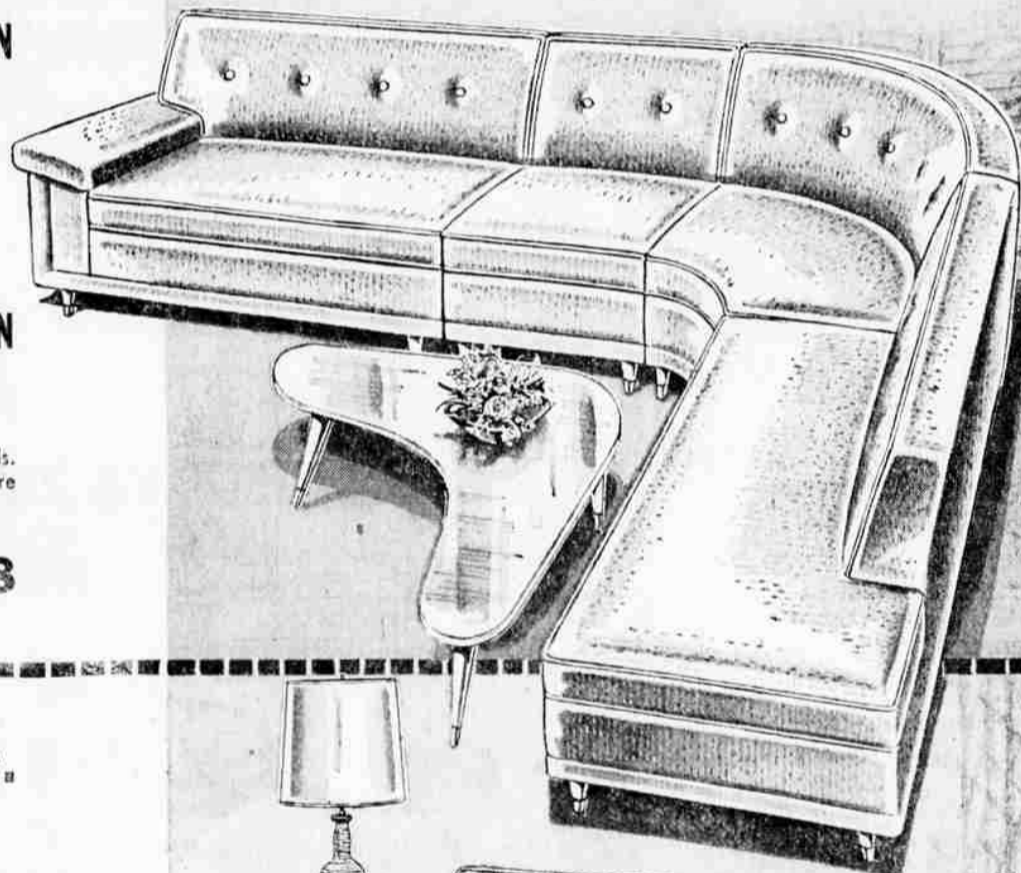

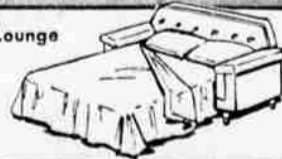

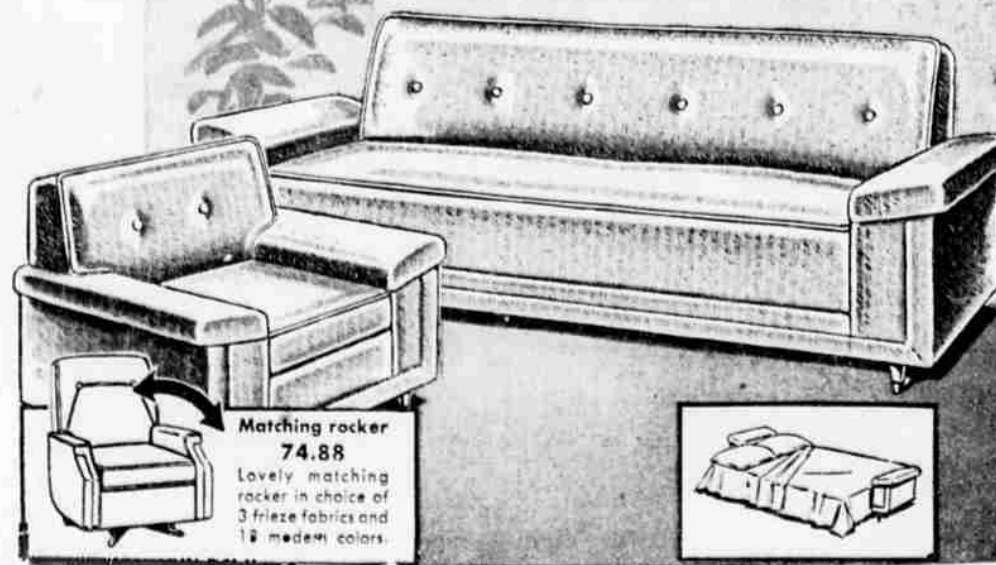
