TCK, TCK! IT'S THE MONOTONY OF THIS INACTIVITY FOR DAYS ON END THAT APPALLS ME!

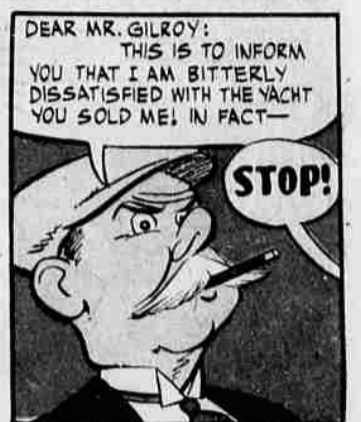


AH'M APPALLED AT WHAT WE SAVED, IN TH' CONFUSION... A TYPEWRITER, AND YOAH SAXOPHONE!
