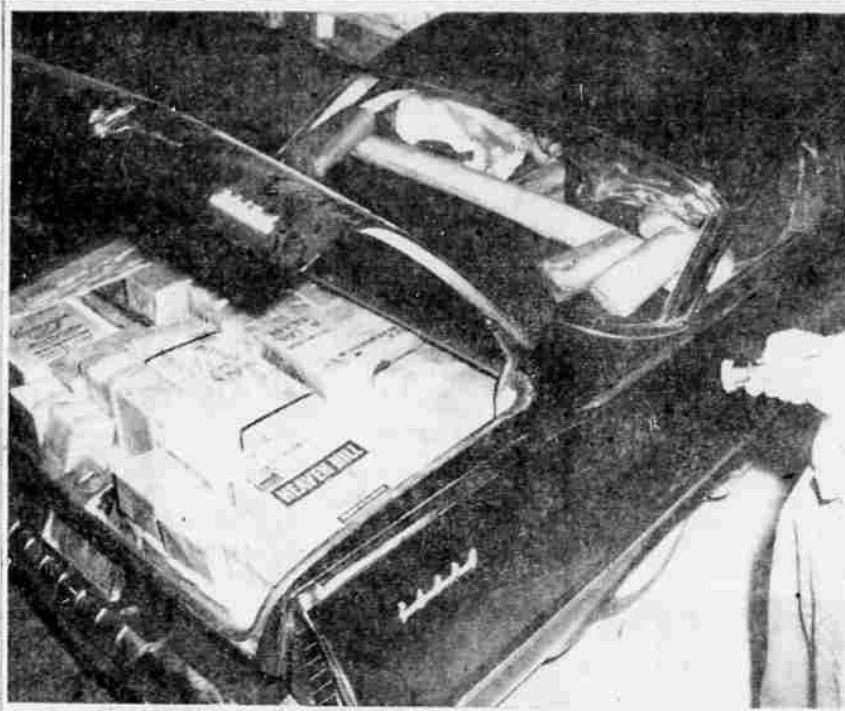
WALL STREET NEW YORK (AP)—The stock market put on a late rally today to close mixed after drifting lower much of the day.
