MEL BYERS

Evangelist To Give Talk

Mel Byers, missionary evangelist who will speak tonight Sunday through Friday at the First Christian Church, lived in the Orient during a time of crisis. His missionary career began when he went to Kunning, China, in 1948. When the Communist invasion forced all missionaries out of China in 1950, Byers, with another missionary, took the overland route from northern China across part of Tibet and down into the Salween Valley. Here they found that the other missionaries and many of the Lisu (Mountain People) Christians had already evacuated into Burma. After visiting the churches of the Salween to strengthen and encourage them, Byers and his companion had to escape into Burma also.

In Burma, Byers remained to work for a year before returning to the United States for a furlough. While here, he attended the School of Missionary Medicine at Biola in Los Angeles.

During this time he met his future wife, June. They were married during this furlough year and returned to the Orient in 1953. They landed in Bangkok, hoping to receive a visa to return to Burma, but soon received a definite refusal from the Burmese government. They turned to work among the tribes of northern Thailand, where they remained the past five years. The work in Thailand has included travel among the mountain tribal villages, teaching at the itinerant preaching and conducting classes for native preachers and teachers.

Byers will have slides of the work and country in Thailand and will show them as part of his presentation here next week. Evening service are at 7:30, and the public is urged to attend.

Groups Plan 3-Day Meet

The Watch Tower Bible and Tract Society officially announced today plans to sponsor a three-day assembly for Jehovah's Witnesses in Redding, October 24 to 26.

Approximately 1,000 delegates from Southern Oregon and Northern California are expected to attend sessions to be held at the Shasta County Fairgrounds, Highway 99 north, Anderson, California.

According to George Hriciszec, spokesman for the group, assemblies of this type are held semi-annually and the purpose is to train Jehovah's Witnesses in their ministry. The theme set for the convention is "Expand Your Ministry."

The program will include morning, afternoon and evening sessions devoted to Bible talks, discussions and demonstrations on conducting home Bible studies. There will be a baptism of new ministers on Saturday with Hriciszec in charge. He has the responsibility of arranging for the immersion facilities, transportation and registration.

Eugene D. Rosam Jr., from world headquarters in Brooklyn, New York, will be the key speaker on the program. Rosam has been in the ministry for 15 years and is now the district supervisor for Jehovah's Witnesses in the western United States and Alaska. His public discourse will climax the assembly of ministers at 3 p.m. Sunday, October 26. The subject will be "The Watch Tower Society in God's Purpose."

"The majority of the members of the Klamath Falls congregation will attend this important Bible seminar," Hriciszec stated.
