### New Pope's First Decision Will Be To Select Name

VATICAN CITY (AP) — One of the first decisions the new Pope will make is the choice of his name. He will be expected to announce his choice almost immediately after his election in this weekend's conclave. What name will he choose? It could be Pius. Most popes choose a name of one of their predecessors with whom they feel some affinity. Eugenio Cardinal Pacelli chose the name Pius XII because of admiration for Pope Pius XI and Pius X. It also could be Benedict. Clement, Gregory or Leo — other names used by popes since 1724. Or it could be one of the names before these became popular. John, used by 22 popes and one antipope (a false claimant to the papacy), still holds the record although it has not been selected in more than 400 years. If the new Pope were to adopt

### Defective Auto Headlight Leads To Youths' Capture

RITZVILLE, Wash. (AP) — A defective automobile headlight led to the capture Thursday night of four armed teen-aged youths, wanted for questioning for a five-day crime spree through Idaho and Washington.

Two state patrolmen, Douglas Treichel and Leland Johnson, apprehended the quartet after an 80-mile an hour automobile chase, which started after the officers noticed the car was operating with only one headlight. The pursuit ended here and the youths offered no resistance.

Found in the 1949 model car the boys were using were items of merchandise, a loaded .22 caliber pistol, 10 knives and a large amount of ammunition.

The car was believed one which was stolen earlier Thursday in Seattle.

The four were identified as Ross Manser, 15, an escapee from an Idaho reformatory; Eugene Coffelt, 15, and Larry Eisenhath, 16, both of Weiser, Idaho, and Larry Martin, 15, whose hometown was not immediately known.

The youths apparently had made their escape in a 19-foot cabin cruiser, which was found Thursday morning aground on a beach in northwest Seattle, across Puget Sound from the peninsula.

Wednesday, three of the four had been picked up by Poulsbo, Wash., police officers but got away when one made a break for freedom.

Weiser, Idaho, authorities wanted

the boys for questioning about burglaries in Idaho and at Reardan, Davenport, Odessa and Ephrata, Wash.
