Plunge In Token Idea Falter

NEW YORK (UPI)—An 18-year-old Brooklyn boy recently attempted to corner the market in subway tokens, in anticipation of a fare rise.

What he did, according to E. Vincent Curtaigne, a member of the New York Transit Authority, was to buy hundreds of dollars worth of tokens at 15 cents apiece with the idea of selling them at a profit when the higher fare went into effect.

Curtaigne, who did not name the

lad, said he got the money to make his purchases, which were perfectly legal, by withdrawing from his own savings account. This was in June, the youngster expecting the fare boost to take place on July 1.

His scheme collapsed on two accounts. First of all, transit police began investigating when they realized somebody was buying an awful lot of tokens.

Second of all, the fares did not go up on July 1. What the young speculator—whose case was dropped—did not know was that there is a law against any fare rise before Jan. 1.

MUSEUM CLEARANCE SALE.
NEW YORK (UPI)—The Metropolitan Museum of Art held a clearance sale this summer and did a thriving business in such articles as neolithic flints, scarabs, jars found in tombs and fragments of stone and pottery. The purchasers were adults and children who visited the Museum during its second annual sale of surplus materials that other museums in the country did not want. The sales have netted the museum about \$230,000, with which it bought a painting, an Egyptian cat sculpture and a couple of other important objects.
