Community Concert Series Set To Open November 6

The first concert of the fall and winter season of community concerts in Klamath Falls will bring America's new dramatic tenor, Albert Da Costa who made his Metropolitan Opera debut in 1956 as Walther in "Die Meistersinger."

November 6 will open the series of artist appearances at the Pelican Theater. Admission is by membership card only. No single admissions will be sold at the door. Doors will open at 7 p.m. The concert will start at 8 p.m. Newcomers to Klamath Falls as well as persons who were out of the city during the membership campaign in March, may obtain memberships from the secretary, Eva Dixon, 424 Main Street.

Hailed as an exciting find, Albert Da Costa, in the amazingly short time of two seasons, has established himself in the front rank of that rarest of all operatic registers, the Heldentenor.

Since his first appearance as Walther in "Die Meistersinger," on January 12, 1956, Da Costa has won recognition in a variety of operatic roles and in concert, both in New York and on tour. At the Metropolitan, he has added important parts in "Boris Godunov," "The Magic Flute," "Der

Rosekavalier," and the title role of "Parisfal" during the 1957 Easter season.

For the American Opera Society, he has been Jason, opposite Eileen Farrell, in the widely acclaimed concert version of Cherubini's "Medea," both at the Karamoor Festival and in New York, and he has appeared in their productions of Rossini's "Otello," "Cavalleria Rusticana" and "I Pagliacci." With the Little Orchestra Society of New York, he has been presented as Bacchus in Strauss' "Ariadne auf Naxos," again with Miss Farrell.

With the Seattle Symphony he sang the title part in Verdi's "Otello." He has also appeared twice in concert with the Minneapolis Symphony and with the Boston Symphony at Tanglewood. His engagements in oratorio include performances with the New York Oratorio Society and the Minneapolis Apollo Club, as a re-

catalogist. Da Costa has filled extensive tours of the Midwest during the past two seasons, singing over 30 engagements each year. Busy schedules lie ahead for the young dramatic tenor. Upon the conclusion of the Metropolitan's 1957 spring tour, he will fly to Trinidad for a series of concerts. During the summer he will go to Europe for recording sessions, which will be interrupted by a fly-
