A report on the candy sale was given and an announcement made that a prize will be given to the bethel member selling the most candy.

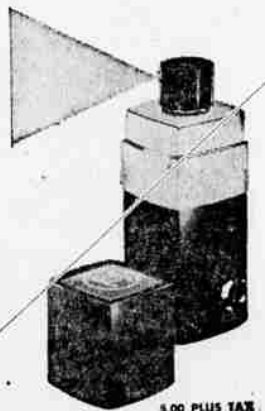
It was voted to buy new crowns for the princesses and queen.

The meeting was concluded with the librarian, Julie Rhodes, giving a clever report.

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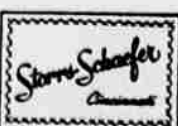
