

Surgery Set For Medico

CHICAGO (UPI) — Dr. Emil H. Grubbe, 83, believed to be the first physician to use X-rays as a cancer treatment, will undergo his first operation Tuesday for the malignancy he contracted during his experiments to aid others.

Fellow doctors said they have never heard a complaint from Grubbe, who already has lost his left hand, his upper lip and jaw, his nose and much of the right side of his face to cancer.

Dr. J. R. Orndorff will amputate parts of the fingers of Grubbe's right hand in Tuesday's operation.

The massive dosages of X-rays Grubbe's body absorbed in his early experiments were blamed for the cancer that now afflicts him.

"If I am going to be as old as Methuselah," he said, "I might as well look like him."



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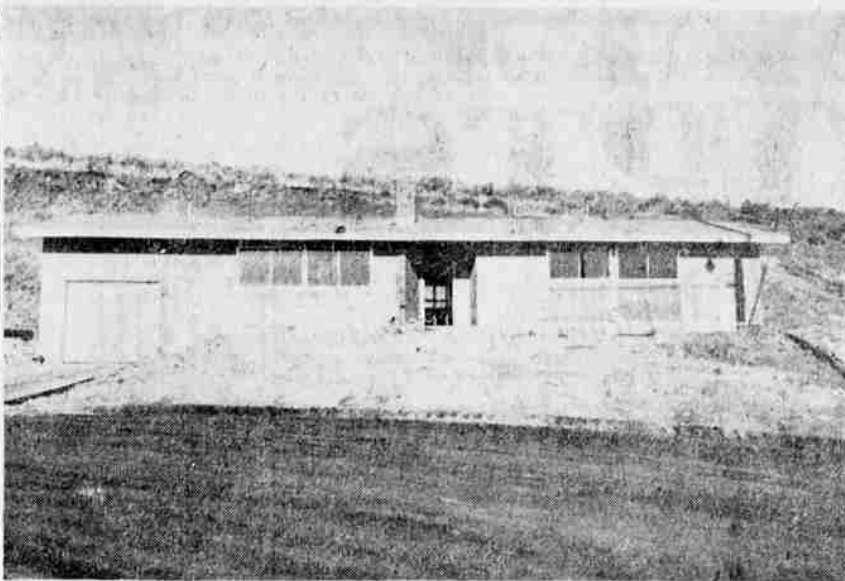

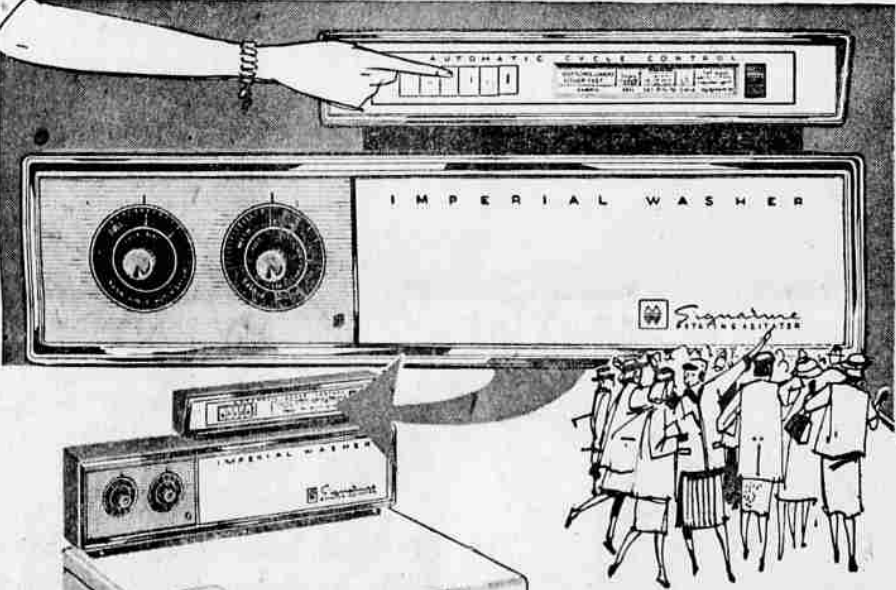

perhaps by chance with tragedy, establishment of a great national jewel collection similar to Britain's crown jewels.

Winston says he has been virtually trouble-free since he acquired the Hope diamond in 1949 from the estate of Evelyn Walsh McLean, the late Washington socialite who owned the diamond for 40 years. He scoffed at the gem's alleged curse.

Yet Mrs. McLean's life was one misfortune on top of another after her husband bought the stone in 1911 for \$100,000.

Two McLean children died violent deaths and McLean himself died in a mental institution.

Other owners of the Hope diamond who contributed to its tragic legend:

—French adventurer Jean Tavernier, who smuggled it out of India in 1642 and was killed by a pack of wild dogs.

—King Louis XI and Marie-Antoinette, beheaded in the French Revolution.

—Turkish Sultan Abdul Hamid, who lost his throne and control of the diamond without getting a cent for it.

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
