Long Hair, R'n'R Mix

NEW YORK (UPI) — A young American composer who dabbles in rock 'n' roll at home has scored a major symphonic success abroad.

Robert Prince, 29, won rave notices for his ballet, "New York Export: Opus Jazz," performed by the Jerome Robbins troupe as part of their "Ballets: U.S.A." program at the Brussels World's Fair. Prior to Brussels, the ballet scored at the Festival of Two Worlds in Spoleto, Italy.

A native New Yorker, Prince was educated at the High School of Music and Art and the Juilliard School of Music.

Robbins "discovered" him through an original jazz album, "What's New," which was commissioned by George Avakian, formerly a Columbia Records executive.

Prince has written arrangements for Johnny Mathis, Louis Armstrong and Tab Hunter, along with dozens of rock 'n' roll performers.

"I'd just as soon not name the rock 'n' roll records," said Prince. "There have been so many. My main interest, of course is serious composition, with a basic jazz orientation."
