Jellied Sun Crowns

Canned cling peaches molded in lemon-flavored gelatin spiced with fresh lemon juice and Sherry wine make a cool, refreshing dessert. "Jellied Peach Sun Crowns" may double as salad, when served with a tart dressing.

JELLIED PEACH SUN CROWNS

1 1/2 cups canned cling peach slices
1 package lemon-flavored gelatin
1 cup hot water
1/4 cup Sherry wine

2 tablespoons fresh lemon juice

Place drained peach slices in swirl pattern in round individual molds. Dissolve gelatin in hot water; add Sherry and lemon juice, and cool until thickened. Pour over peach slices. Chill until firm. Makes six to eight molds.



LIBBY'S new Deep Minted Pineapple and new one-quart size cans of juices are being introduced in the Klamath Falls area. The pineapple chunks are as golden as you expect pineapple to be and have a surprise mint flavor. They make an excellent garnish for a roast leg of lamb, a fruit garnish to a minted frappe or an added flavor taste to top a fruit salad. Use as an accent, not as the major ingredient. The slim quart size cans of juices and nectars are convenient for refrigerator storage alongside milk containers and should be a popular item. The shopper will not find these items in all of the Klamath Falls stores, principally because Libby's advertising at the present time is not carried at the local level. Your grocer, with justification, exerts most of his promotion efforts on products which are advertised in his daily newspaper.

SALAD IDEA

Spoon blue lake green beans (which have been marinated in French dressing) into tomatoes cut open in flower fashion. Garnish with deviled egg quarters and shiny ripe Wyandotte olives. Serve with garnish of greens.

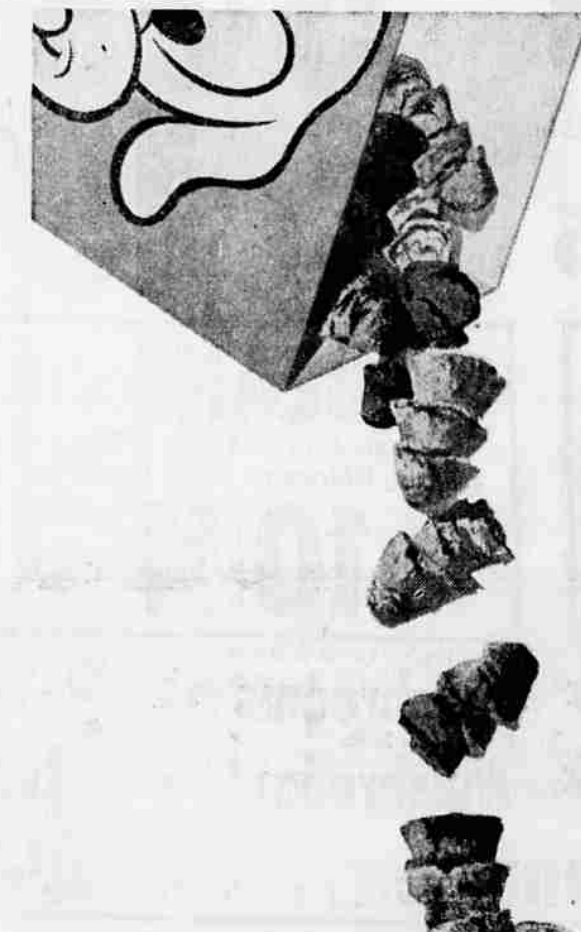
