Alaska Report Given Church
Members of the Seventh-day Adventist Church, Klamath Falls, have received an encouraging report from work of the church being accomplished in Alaska following a recent trip by the president of the Alaskan field.
The trip took him from Ketchikan to Kotzebue, northernmost city in the new state.
Churches, schools and a few dispensaries have been established also in Neets Bay, Craig, Wrangell, Juneau, Sitka, Fairbanks, Anchorage, Palmer, Dillingham, Aleknagik, Bristol Bay, Savoonga, Gambel, and Selawik.
Many of the pastors and teachers in these churches are graduates of the Seventh-day Adventist College in Walla Walla.
Dr. Edwin Kraft, a graduate of Loma Linda Medical School, is stationed at Anchorage where he is carrying medical missionary work to persons in that area. Dr. John Libby from the same college is stationed at Anchorage in the medical clinic sponsored by the Seventh Day Adventist Church. The church also built the first sanatorium and church school in the Matanuska Valley at Palmer.
The local SDA congregation has been commended for the part played in establishing worship opportunities in Alaska.
