By THE ASSOCIATED PRESS. Johnny Unitas, a Colt with a 45 for a passing arm, is healthy again. He proved it Sunday, shooting down the title bid of the Los Angeles Rams and passing Baltimore to a 34-7 victory.

The New York Giants kept a game with three remaining. The Rams' passing ran up 244 yards, but four interceptions, combined with live fumbles, made their attack ineffective.

In the West, the Chicago Bears took over sole possession of second place by beating the Detroit Lions 29-7 while Los Angeles faltered. The Lions' defeat eliminated the defending world champions from title consideration.

Colts 34, Rams 7

Unitas, who suffered two cracked ribs in the Green Bay game three weeks ago, lit that spark the first time he passed. Dodging tackles behind scrimmage at his own 42, he hit speedy receiver Lennie Moore on the Ram 18 and the ex-Penn State halfback kept going for the score.

Bears 20, Lions 7

The Bears, beaten twice by the Colts, can only hope that the Baltimore team loses to either the Rams or the 49ers, whom the Colts meet home-and-home. The Chicago team kept in the running at Detroit Sunday thanks to Zeke Bratkowski and Bill McColl, who combined for two scoring passes in the

third period when Detroit had a 7-6 lead. Chicago Bears: TD, McColl 2 (5 pass from Bratkowski), PAT, Blanda 2. FG, Blanda 2 (15, 35).

Browns 28, Eagles 14

With the great Jimmy Brown being held to a season low of 66 yards rushing and without a touchdown this year, Mitchell made the difference at Cleveland where the Eagles played the Browns even after the first period. Eagle quarterback Norm Van Brocklin passed for 210 yards on 18 of 29 throws, one for a touchdown.

Giants 30, Skins 0

Those unpredictable, quarterback Charley Conerly and placement kicker Pat Summerall, were on course at New York as the Giants scored their first shutout of the season. Summerall booted three field goals for a 9-0 lead before Conerly took over and passed for a pair of touchdowns. Don Heinrich threw for another Giant score as the Redskins gave up 173 yards in the air and 185 on the ground.

At Chicago, Bobby Layne connected with Jimmy Orr of the Steelers on a 78-yard scoring pass in the fourth period to break a 20-20 tie with the Cardinals. Tom Miner, the league FG leader with 12, kicked two for the Steelers, and rookie Bobby Conrad booted a pair for the Cards.

49ers 33, Packers 12

At Milwaukee, where the Packers' 49er game ended with five players being ejected for fighting, Y. A. Tittle threw for three touchdowns. Two of them came in the final period when the 49ers rolled for 21 points after the Packers' Paul Hornung and the San Francisco's Gordy Soltau each kicked two field goals to help fashion a 12-12 tie.

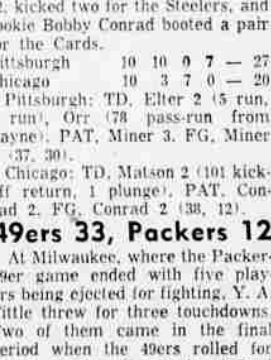
