Dinner Meet Hears Nixon

LONDON (P)—Vice President Nixon Wednesday night welcomed Soviet Premier Khrushchev's threat to outstrip the West in the battle for better standards of living.

"If Mr. Khrushchev wishes to consider these steps as a form of competition or contest," Nixon said in a banquet speech, "I am sure all of us would be delighted to accept the challenge. In such a contest, no one could really lose."

"The world would be infinitely better off if man's energies were used for the welfare of families rather than the building of armies."

The banquet was given for Nixon by the English-Speaking Union in London's ancient Guildhall. It wound up the second day of his four day stay in Britain.

The vice president urged the West to make its chief goal "the victory of plenty over want, of

health over disease, of freedom over tyranny."

"Let us speak less of the threat of communism and more of the promise of freedom," he said.
