Demos Sweep Alaska Win

JUNEAU, Alaska (AP) — The new state of Alaska had its tent pitched solidly in the Democratic camp today as the ballot counting on Tuesday's general election took a Thanksgiving Day recess. The Democrats, turning the election into a landslide, picked up both of Alaska's U.S. Senate seats, the state's lone seat in the U.S. House of Representatives and the governor's mansion. They won absolute control of Alaska's first state Legislature.

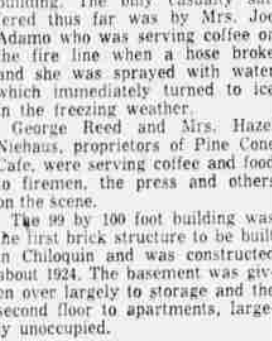

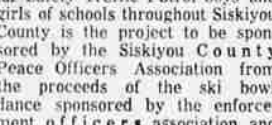
