Reduction Plant Operation Started By Mining Firm

LAKEVIEW — The reduction plant was put into operation last weekend on schedule by the Lakeview Mining Company, the \$6½ million uranium operation at Lakeview, according to company officials.

In fact, ore was fed into the fine ore bins from the rod mill one day ahead of schedule, it is reported. During the first two weeks of operation, both construction and operating personnel are on the job.

Ex-Soviet Army Officer Plans Return To Russia

PORTLAND (AP)—Vladimir Petrovich had made up his mind. In a letter to the Oregon Journal, the stocky Russian, who served in the Soviet Army in World War II, said:

"I arrived in Portland as a displaced person in 1949. Nearly nine years have passed since. Now, following my own convictions and wishes, I have decided to return to my motherland."

"My decision was made without any pressure from the Soviet Union. This is my voluntary decision."

"Leaving as I am the USA and the city of Portland, to which I have become so accustomed these past years, I would like to express my heartfelt wishes to my friends as well as to all American people."

"As I leave the USA and especially the city of Portland, I wish with all my heart to take with me good and kind remembrances of America."

"I don't know exactly what is in store for me in my homeland, which I have never ceased to love, but this is not the point of this letter."

"It is that I wish with all my heart that these two great nations — America and Russia — would disregard their differing political orders and stop concentrating on the destruction of world culture and civilization."

"I wish with all my heart that the strong economic resources of these countries... would be directed to the good of all the civilized world."

"All this is possible and attainable if people with clean hearts will strive toward the realization of this goal."

"I wish you all happiness and health in peaceful and constructive labor for peace, and for the humanity of the whole world."

The letter was written in flawless Russian. Petrovich spoke in halting English in an interview with the newspaper.

"I always wanted to go back. I loved my country then. I still love it. I don't think they do anything to me. They say not. I believe them."

School Eyes Withdrawal

DORRIS — An investigating committee will be appointed to study the possible withdrawal of the Butte Valley Farm Bureau Extension area from Siskiyou Union High School District. A group of 25 Butte Valley School trustees and citizens voted last week, when they met at Macdoel Elementary School, to appoint the committee.

Representatives from the board of trustees of Mount Hebron, Redrock, Macdoel and Dorris Elementary School districts and from each of the interested service organizations in the area will be on the committee.

W. E. Roberts, Siskiyou County superintendent of schools, was invited by Mrs. Don Griffin of the Butte Valley Farm Bureau Center to explain the legal aspects of the withdrawal situation.

Roberts offered three alternatives to the assemblage: First, joining with Tulelake Joint Union High School District and dropping from the Siskiyou Joint Junior College District as well as the high school district.

Second, unification with Tulelake High School District, with elementary and secondary schools in the Tulelake-Dorris attendance area under a single board, and removal from the junior college district.

Third, withdrawal and unification of Mount Hebron, Macdoel, Redrock and Dorris Elementary School districts with Dorris High School — in which case the unified district would remain within the junior college district.

Butte Valley voters voted against setting up the college district and the sale of bonds to construct a college plant.

Ray McIntyre, trustee from Dorris on the Siskiyou Union High School Board, represented the Siskiyou district at the meeting. McIntyre said there probably would be a meeting in January of all interested parties concerning the withdrawal.
