understanding that has brought her high praise from even the severest critics. She is descended from a long line of Biblical dramatists, dating back to her great-grandfather, Alexander Shephard, who appeared in the Passion Play in Switzerland.

The play, to be presented in the Pelican Theater under auspices of the Klamath Falls Kiwanis Club will open for a three-day performance on Friday, December 12, at 8:15 p.m.

Evening performances will be given Friday, Saturday and Sunday, an afternoon Sunday matinee at 2:30 p.m. and a special student matinee on Friday and Saturday at a nominal charge.

In addition to giving this exacting performance, Mrs. Balfour works closely with her husband in creating color combinations for the play's costumes. These must harmonize with the elaborate lighting effects for the 25 scenes of the play. The 200 costumes created for the production are a combination of Biblical authenticity and realistic modern materials. One of the most effective scenes is The Last Supper which in its composition is patterned after the famous Leonardo da Vinci painting.

EGGNOG PIE
1 cup fine graham cracker crumbs
1/2 cup melted butter or margarine
1/2 cup PET Evaporated Milk
1 1/2 pkgs. unflavored gelatin
2 eggs, separated
1/2 cup sugar
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 Tablespoon vanilla
1/4 teaspoon rum flavoring (can omit)
1/2 cup PET Evaporated Milk
Press mixture of crumbs and butter on bottom and sides of 9-in. pie pan. Chill until needed. Chill 1/2 cup PET Milk in ice tray until almost frozen around edges. Meanwhile, soften gelatin in 1/2 cup cold water. Stir in 1/2 cup boiling water until gelatin dissolves. In 1 1/2-qt. bowl mix slightly beaten egg yolks, sugar, salt, vanilla, rum flavoring and 1/2 cup PET Milk. Stir in dissolved gelatin gradually. Chill until very thick, but not set, stirring now and then. Put egg whites and chilled PET Milk into cold 1-qt. bowl. Whip with cold rotary beater by hand, or with electric beater at high speed, until stiff. Beat in chilled gelatin mixture gradually, until smooth and creamy. Put into crumb crust. Chill until firm, about 2 hrs., and ready to serve.
