GOP Must Get To People, Says Oregon's New Chief

HONOLULU (UPI)—Governor-elect Mark Hatfield of Oregon said Monday night Republican must "get out of headquarters and out among the people" if they expect to win elections from the Democrats.

Hatfield, speaking informally at a gathering of prominent local Republican and community leaders, said he attributed his success to the fact "we broke out of the hallowed halls of the Republican

party—we went out to meet the people."

Instead of attending the rallies set up by his party, Hatfield said he spent his time handshaking and sawmills. My wife was at supermarkets doing the same. I think it was the personal application."

Hatfield arrived Monday by plane to attend the Western Republican Conference. He was one of the few Republicans in the nation to defeat a Democrat incumbent. He has been asked to tell the conference about his system this Thursday.

Hatfield said that Vice President Richard M. Nixon telephoned him after the election to congratulate him.

"He told me the most stupid blunder Republicans made was to embrace the right-to-work legislation," Hatfield said. "I agree with Mr. Nixon on that."

Hatfield said the trend is away from Republican conservatism of the past. "I think we had definite milestones around our neck in the past election in the way of candidates," he said.

Asked to name names, he paused and then stuck his chin out.

"There was Bricker (of Ohio), Malone (of Nevada) and there was Knowland (of California)—frankly I don't think he was one of our greatest selections."

"I think we had too many men who don't know we are in the 20th century. The people I've mentioned didn't realize that you have to stay in touch with the people—don't wait until six weeks before the election."

Judge Fines Woman Driver

Oregon's law that prohibits a driver from passing a school bus that is loading or unloading children resulted in a \$25 fine in Klamath County District Court Tuesday.

Judge D. E. Van Vactor levied the fine upon a driver who said she was not aware of having passed a stopped school bus but said she may have done so inadvertently.

Bus driver John Keegan testified that the auto driver, Mrs. Marie Dixon, had passed his bus which was stopped to unload two boys returning home from Altamont School on November 4.

Keegan and one of the boys, Michael O'Connell, 13, both took the car's license number. Another boy, Jimmy Sheridan, also 13, testified on the color of the car. Mrs. Dixon said she had been

driving the car that day but had no knowledge of passing a stopped school bus. She said she may have done so inadvertently.

"I agree that it probably was inadvertent," Judge Van Vactor said. "Nevertheless I'll have to fine you."

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CAA Seeking Applicants

The Civil Aeronautics Administration has not received a sufficient number of qualified applicants for the following positions included in its recent examination for flight operations and air worthiness inspector: Engineering flight test inspector; air carrier electronics inspector; and general aviation electronics inspector. The closing date for acceptance of applications for these positions has been extended until further notice to give additional qualified persons an opportunity to apply. The entrance salaries range from \$5,985 to \$8,330 a year.

Most of the positions are located throughout the United States; however, some positions will be filled in Washington, D.C., and in U.S. territories and possessions and in some foreign countries.

The duties of the positions deal directly with the safety of human life in transportation by air and involve a considerable amount of travel. Applicants must have had responsible experience in aviation activities pertinent to the position for which they apply. Appropriate education may be substituted for part of the required experience. Applicants for the position of engineering flight test inspector must be experienced pilots.

Full information regarding the requirements and how to apply may be obtained at many post offices throughout the United States, or from the U.S. Civil Service Commission in Washington, D.C. Applications will be accepted by the Board of U.S. Civil Service Examiners, Civil Aeronautics Administration, Washington 25, D.C., until further notice.

Vancouver Firm Given Contract

Peter Kiewit Sons Company of Vancouver, Washington, was low bidder in Salem Tuesday morning for construction of a 224 foot overpass to carry the Dalles-California Highway over the Southern Pacific Railroad and the Pelican City road, a leg of the west side bypass to Klamath Falls.

In the bids opened at 10 a.m., Peter Kiewit Sons Company bid \$71,648 for the reinforced concrete structure which is expected to be completed during the summer of 1959.

Contract for the construction is expected to be awarded by the State Highway Commission on Thursday.

Contract Given To Eugene Firm

A Eugene contracting firm was low bidder for work involved in installing a north boundary fence at Kingsley Field at the bid opening at 11 a.m. on December 8, according to Harry F. Keating, base procurement officer for the 408th Fighter Group.

An award has been made to San Jose Steel Company, Inc., 2472 Willamette Street, Eugene, on its low bid of \$2,572.

Six bids were received at the bid opening, Keating said.

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
