Convict Confesses Slaying Of Alabama Vice Crusader

MONTGOMERY, Ala. (AP)—A Virginia convict has confessed to the 1954 slaying of vice crusader Albert Patterson, Gov. James E. Folsom's office said Wednesday.

There appears to be a degree of truthfulness in the signed statement of Calvin W. Pruitt, 29, who said he shot the attorney general-elect in a robbery attempt while a debt-ridden soldier stationed at Fort Benning, the governor said.
