Solon Scores Chief's Plan

WASHINGTON (AP)—The suggestion by President Eisenhower that two years be added to the high school curriculum is "impractical and unwise," Rep. Al Ullman (D-Ore.) said Wednesday. Ullman said the nation, instead, should strengthen the existing school system, and build more two-year junior colleges. At the next session of Congress, Ullman plans to introduce again a bill to permit the federal government help build junior colleges. Ullman said the President's suggestion for lengthening the high school course has been tested at various times since 1908. The plan, said Ullman, has been found wanting. Eisenhower made the suggestion at a White House conference Tuesday.

Transit Company To Cut Service

PORTLAND (AP)—Rose City Transit Co. received permission Wednesday from the Portland City Council to curtail service on four lines. The city's mass transit service firm was authorized to eliminate Sunday service on the Woodstock and Bridge Transfer runs and limit it on the Killingsworth and Atlington - Kings Heights - West runs. It also was told it could stop service on all four runs after 6:30 p.m. The permission becomes effective Jan. 11.

Car Driven Off By Wrong Person

Jury Announces Death Accident

LA GRANDE (AP)—The Dec. 4 traffic death of a teen-ager in nearby Elgin was an accident, a coroner's jury ruled Wednesday night. The jury was called to deliberate in the death of John Lee Shaffer, 18, La Grande. Earlier, the driver of the car, Richard L. Parsons, 38, Elgin, told police that Shaffer had appeared suddenly in front of his car, walking along a dark street. Parsons said he swerved, but was unable to avoid hitting the youth.

Gas Discovered In Lebanon Well

PORTLAND (AP)—"A little gas" was disclosed Wednesday by tests at a well drilled near Lebanon by the Linn County Development Corp., Hollis Dole said. Dole, the director of the Oregon Department of Geology and Mineral Industries, said: "They went down to test for gas. They did get a little, but not very much. 'The way it looks to us, it's not at all exciting. And we're willing to forget the whole thing. There is no trace of oil.'"

The company, though, plans to run more tests, Dole said.

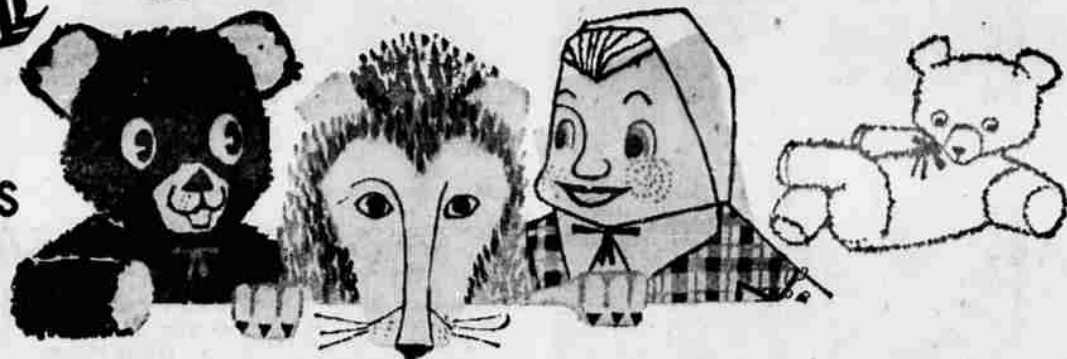
RETURN SCHEDULED
