STUFFED YAMS

Fill yam shells with the mixture and return to oven for 15 to 20 minutes.

BEAN SOUP

2-3 cup ripe olives
2 1/2 cups cooked navy beans
3 cups water
1 1/2 teaspoons instant minced onion or 2 tablespoons finely chopped raw onion
1 teaspoon salt
1/4 cup cooked tomatoes
Cut olives into large pieces. Cook beans with water, onion and salt about 20 minutes. Mash about half the beans in the soup mixture. Stir in tomatoes and olives. Heat thoroughly and serve. Makes 5 to 6 servings.

1/4 cup dried figs
1-3 cup each shredded citron

MEXICAN COLE SLAW

1 cup ripe olives
3 cups shredded cabbage
1 cup shredded carrot
2 tablespoons finely-chopped green pepper
1/2 cup mayonnaise
1 tablespoon vinegar
2 teaspoons sugar
1 teaspoon salt
Lettuce
Cut olives into large wedges. Combine with cabbage, carrot and green pepper. Blend mayonnaise with vinegar, sugar and salt, and mix lightly with vegetable mixture. Serve on lettuce-garnished salad plates. Serves 8.

candied pineapple and halved cherries
1/2 pound marshmallows
1-3 cup milk, brandy or dry sherry wine
1 tablespoon instant coffee powder
3 cups graham cracker crumbs

Rinse and dry raisins and figs. Remove stems from figs and slice them. Combine dried fruits with candied fruits. Melt marshmallows in milk or other liquid; place over very low heat, stirring often. Stir in coffee powder. Pour over cracker crumbs and mix well. Add fruit mixture, blending in thoroughly.

Pack into small, greased loaf pans and cover with aluminum foil. Chill overnight, or longer, before slicing. Keep in refrigerator constantly. Makes 2 1/2 pounds of cake.

CHRISTMAS FUN

To get the small fry out from under foot, let them make decorations for the family Christmas tree. A big bowl of popped corn and a package of fresh cranberries can provide a lot of busy work. Garlands of the red and white alternated are pretty on the tree. The smaller youngsters can string garlands of macaroni or cereals which have holes in them. Paper crayons, tinsel, string, paste and scissors can be provided on a table-out of the way—for all ages to make cards, labels and tree decorations.

SAUCE FOR HAM
Drain syrup from an 11-ounce can of Mandarin oranges. Add 1 1/2 teaspoons cornstarch, 1/4 teaspoon cloves, 1/4 teaspoon each cinnamon and nutmeg, 2 tablespoons sugar and 1/2 cup pineapple juice. Bring to a full rolling boil, stirring constantly. Add 1 tablespoon butter and the orange sections and serve over slices of baked ham.
