

Modoc County 'Land King' Aids College

ALTURAS — Mills College announced on December 18 that it has received \$151,000 in advance gifts and pledges toward a goal of \$250,000 to endow a professorship in honor of Lynn T. White Jr., former president of the Oakland, California, institution for women.

McArthur, often referred to as the land king of Modoc County, gave \$15,000 to Mills College toward the construction of a new gymnasium while his daughter and her husband lived on the campus.

Dr. White resigned after 15 years as Mills' president last June to devote full time to research writing and teaching. He now is a professor of medieval history at the University of California at Los Angeles.
