Commies Claim RR Achievement

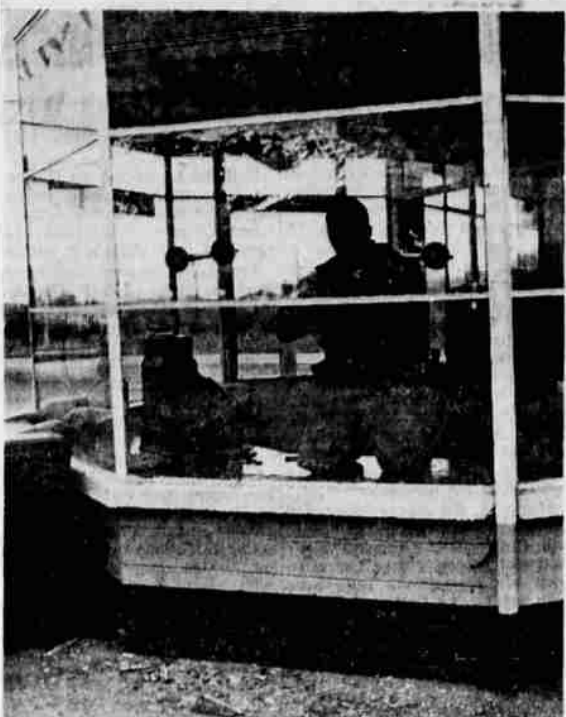
