Shanty Town Study Made

LIMA, Peru (UPI)—The rapid spread of "shanty town" slums around South America's major cities was the subject of a major Inter-American conference here November 18-27.

Housing authorities from the U.S. and 20 Latin American republics pooled their knowledge to map plans for an urgent effort to eradicate or transform the so-called "barrios brujos," dense conglomerations of inadequate dwellings lacking the most elementary sanitary services.

The shanty towns reflect Latin America's rapid population growth, and the tendency for population to concentrate around cities. The housing experts estimated that Latin America needs at least 1,000,000 new dwellings each year just to keep pace with population growth.
