Debt Erased By Church

The last payment owed on the First Baptist Church, Klamath Falls, has been made and the \$65,000 indebtedness, paid since 1950, was wiped out officially with the burning of the mortgage New Year's Eve during a Watch Night ceremony.

The match was applied by Charles W. Thomas, member of the local church for 52½ years and prior to his affiliation here, a member in Colorado. He is presently a trustee of the church. He came to Klamath Falls in 1905.

Since his arrival here, Mr. Thomas has served as a councilman for four terms, as a member of the No. 1 city school board for 12 years, has been a Kiwanian and a member of the Masonic Lodge, AF&M for many years. He was in the plastering contracting business before retiring. The business is now operated by his son, Beverly Thomas.

Thomas has been active in helping raise funds for liquidation of the church mortgage. He observed his 82nd birthday January 2. Extensive improvements including the construction of a new educational unit has been completed since the arrival of Dr. E. M. Causey as pastor.
