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New Career For Cesare Siepi

There's a record album out now that may herald a whole new career for Cesare Siepi, the Met's great basso. It's "Easy to Love" on London Records (only stereo now, but monaural will follow soon). It is a collection of Cole Porter songs, done beautifully. This isn't such a departure for Siepi, at that. The tall, handsome singer likes to remember that, at 15, he was a member of a jazz singing group in Milan. But it's actually been a long time between pop engagements for him, although he's followed pop songs and singers. But he made a point of not listening to any recordings of the songs he sings in the album—"not because I don't admire the singers, but because I wanted to come by something of my own." And he has. There's a strong possibility this all may lead to a musical comedy career for Siepi, something he'd like very much—provided the part was right and he could sandwich it in somehow. But no night clubs. "I don't think they would be for me," he says. "I don't have what is known as a routine."

First Ladies Of California Have Photos In Mansion

SACRAMENTO (UPI) — Mrs. Virginia Knight, wife of outgoing Gov. Goodwin J. Knight, Wednesday displayed a collection of photographs of all the first ladies of California who lived in the present Governor's Mansion. She explained that portraits of all the state's governors hang in the Capitol, so it was "appropriate to hang pictures of the first ladies in their home—the mansion." The group of 11 photos begins with the picture of Mrs. George C. Pardee, wife of California's 21st governor. The Pardees were the first gubernatorial family to occupy the 80-year-old mansion. An empty frame hangs next to Mrs. Knight's picture. She said she expected Mrs. Bernice Brown, wife of Gov.-elect Edmund G. Brown, to fill the frame with her photo when the Browns move into the mansion Monday. Mrs. Knight said the picture which was most difficult to obtain was that of Mrs. Hiram Johnson, who had a life-long aversion to having her picture taken. The only available photograph of the railroad-busting governor and long-time U.S. senator was found in the morgue of a Sacramento newspaper (The Bee). The photo, a newspaper engraving—was refurbished and enlarged before it was added to the collection. Included along with Mrs. Pardee.
