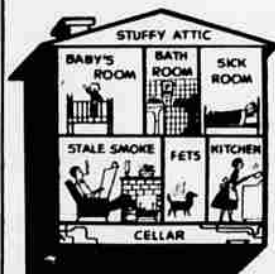

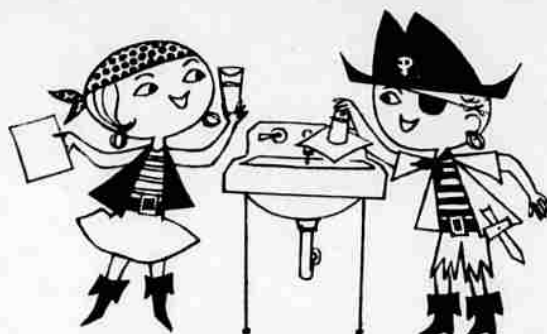

Air Holds Water in a Glass

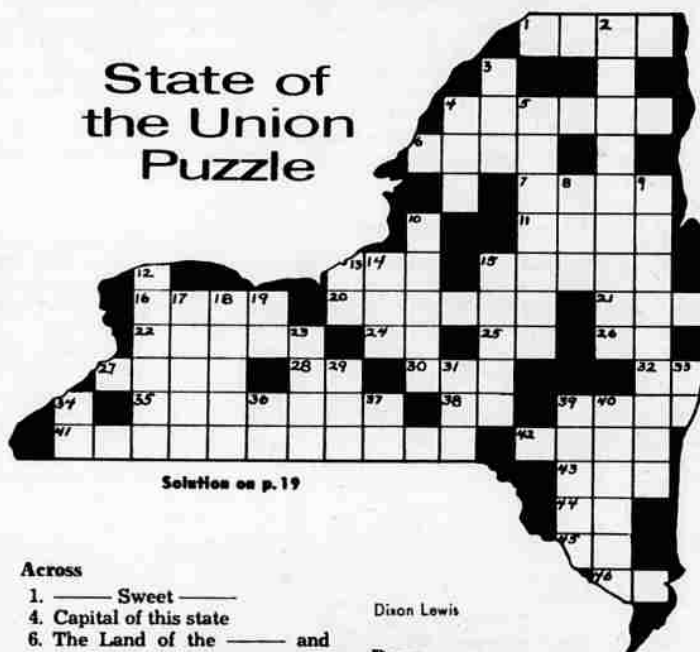

Snitch Jane McHenry

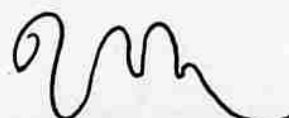
Parallel lines of players stand a

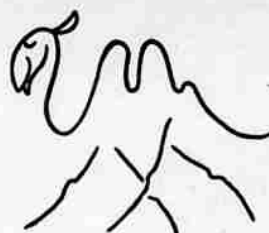

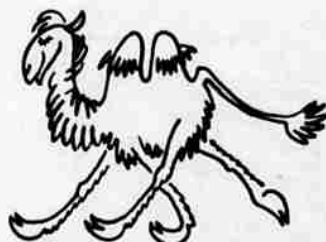
A simple squiggle that we make
