LA Trip Said Key For Bears

SAN FRANCISCO (UPI)—California's chances of winning its third straight Pacific Coast Conference basketball title could rise or fall in Los Angeles early next month, according to Coach Pete Newell's crystal ball.

"We'll still be in the race or out of it after the two game series, there," Newell told the Northern California Basketball Writers and Broadcasting Association Monday.

The Bears, now trailing front-running UCLA by a half-game, meet the Bruins on Feb. 6 and Southern California the next night. That will be the first conference action in two weeks for Newell's squad, which has been beset with most other PCC quintets by mid-term exams.

"In the meantime, we're just about where we thought we'd be," Newell said. "Washington still is a good team after a slow start. I think that the team which can win at least half its games on the road will take the title."

Jim Weaver, whose St. Mary's team leads the West Coast Athletic Conference with a 3-0 mark, was happy that the Gaels also have an idle fortnight on hand. "Tom Meschery can use that period to get back into shape more from his leg injury and that will make us tougher," Weaver said. "If it wasn't for him, we could not have beaten Santa Clara last Friday."

Coach Phil Woolpert of USF joined the rest of the Dons in hoping that Fred LaCour, the stylish forward who ran into grade trouble, would be able to pass his exams and rejoin the squad.

"If he makes it, we'll put him back in his regular position and move Charley Range back to guard," Woolpert said. "Charley is a natural guard to begin with."

Both Bob Feorick of Santa Clara and Van Sweet of College of the Pacific sought to put the hex on Weaver by saying he might go undefeated while winning the conference championship.

"St. Mary's can be beat but might wind up undefeated in the conference," Feorick said. Weaver added that he felt the same. Weaver, pressed to give his own sentiments, parried the question with "come on, there's enough on my back already."

At Buch, California's guard and captain, was named player of the week.

NBA All-Star Classic Friday

DETROIT (AP)—The 20 greatest stars in professional basketball will compete Friday night at Detroit's Olympia Stadium in the National Basketball Assn.'s ninth annual All-Star game.

Before the mid-winter classic begins, the league's board of governors will meet Thursday to consider league problems.

The race problem came up last weekend when rookie Elgin Baylor of the Minneapolis Lakers said he and two other Lakers were refused accommodations at a hotel in Charleston, W. Va. Baylor refused to play in the game.

The board of governors will set dates for its draft meeting, and select dates and a site for the NBA's annual meeting, and also will complete playoff plans.

Proposed rule changes and the question of expanding the league to 10 or more teams also will be discussed.

In the All-Star game, stars of the Eastern Division will be after their seventh victory against two losses.
