Many Aides In Congress Make More Than Bosses

WASHINGTON (AP) — Many congressional hired hands are faring better financially than are their bosses. It is estimated that 248 of them are being paid more than \$16,000 each per year, while more than 500 others are eligible for upwards of \$10,000 each. That's considerably less than the \$22,500 annual salary paid senators and representatives, but the difference is more imaginary than real.
